CAINE, SARAH M. - (Mrs. William J. Caine); Mother of Maggie and Thomas Caine - 1851 - Dec 17, 1894

CAINE, WALTER DOUGLAS - Tram Accident - Husband of Mary Jayne Smith; Son of Ben and Ethel Marie Brown Caine; Brother of Dorothy, Ethel, Ruth, John "Jack", Robert G. and Robert Lewis (White)Caine; Grandson of John and Mary Lean Higgins Brown and of Phillips and Mary Ann Corkle Cain(e) - Nov 18, 1917 - Nov 13, 1941

CAINE, WILLIAM JAMES - Husband of Sarah Caine; Father of Maggie, Thomas, another son, and another daughter - Died Feb 2, 1899 - Age 52 Years

CALDWELL, INFANT BOY - Son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Caldwell (or Colwell) - 1896 - Jan 12, 1897

CALHOUN, KATIE - Daughter of J.C. and Mary Henry Calhoun - Died May 12, 1891 - Age 10 Yrs

CALLAHAN, BOY - Son of Con and Jane Hackett Callahan - Sept 25, 1895 - Jan 31, 1898

CALLAHAN, CORNELIUS DENNIS "CON" - Husband of Jane Hackett; Father of Dennis R., Esther and Henry Callahan and Four Other Children; Son of Dennis Callahan - July 1847 - Jan 14, 1906

CALLAHAN, EDWARD JAMES (or Henry) - Son of Con and Jane Hackett Callahan (This child was referred to in the newspapers as both Edward James and Henry) - Died Mar 2, 1899

CALLAHAN, INFANT - Child of Con and Jane Hackett Callahan - Died Dec 11, 1892

CALLAHAN, INFANT - Child of Con and Jane Hackett Callahan - Apr 24, 1894 - Apr 26, 1894

CALLAHAN, INFANT TWIN GIRL - Daughter of Con and Jane Hackett Callahan; Sister of Esther and Dennis Callahan (her twin) - Twins, a boy and a girl, were born Feb 3, 1897 to Mr. and Mrs. Con Callahan. The little girl was stillborn

CHRISTENSEN, ISTEELLA - Daughter of James J. and Jane Christensen; Sister of Helen M. and Lillie (or Lilla) N. Christensen (later Clarke) - Jan 5, 1892 - Mar 11, 1892
CHRISTENSEN, JAMES J. - Husband of Jane; Father of Istella, Lillie and Helen M. Christensen - 1854 - June 24, 1898
CHRISTENSON - See Christensen
CHRISTOFFERSON, VICTOR EMANUEL - Crushed in Gold King Mine - Died Jan 17, 1907 - Age 43 Years - Name was usually spelled "Kristofferson" in Silverton
CHURCHILL, ALVIN FLINT "AL" - Husband of Ella Arthur; Father of Jennie and a Son - Dec 9, 1858 - Sept 30, 1903

CLEAVINGER, IRMA MARGUERITE QUARNSTROM - (Mrs. Eugene H. Cleavinger); Daughter of Louis and Edla Svedenborg Quarnstrom; Sister of Dagmar Kitty Quarnstrom - August 8, 1906 - Died between 1989 and October 1992

CLEVINGER, JUDSON C. - Relative of W.H. Clevenger - 1885 - Feb 12, 1915

CLIFFORD, EARL MARTIN - Husband Of Ethel Kimzey Nordlund; Father of Rosalie Geneva and Earlene Marie Clifford; Son of James & Genevieve McLeod Clifford; Brother of Harold James "Topsy", Arline, Donald McLeod "Scotty" and Robert Daniel Clifford - Apr 30, 1907 - Oct 16, 1957

CLIFFORD, ETHEL KIMZEY NORDLUND - "Brownie" (Mrs. Earl Martin Clifford); Mother of Earlene Marie and Rosalie Clifford, Lorraine and Floyd Nordlund; Daughter of Luther and Ivy Laura Randall Kimzey; Granddaughter of William and Anna Peterson Randa - April 15, 1898 - Dec 19, 1953

CLIFFORD, JAMES MARTIN - Husband of Genevieve McLeod; Father of Earl Martin, Harold James "Topsy", Arline Genevieve, Donald McLeod "Scotty" and Robert Daniel Clifford; Brother of Patrick Joseph Clifford - Mar 22, 1872 - Sept 3, 1941

CLIFFORD, JAMES ROBERT - Only Child of Harold James "Topsy" and Nada Lilly Shaffer Clifford - Dec 30, 1933 - Jan 2, 1934 - Age 3 Days

COLE MAUSOLEUM - The Cole Mausoleum is located in Sector (4) of Hillside Cemetery, on the lower side of the lower road. Several generations of the Cole family are entombed here. The mausoleum, of white Durango sandstone, was built in 1913 by William "Billy" Cole, pioneer merchant of Silverton. It was one of the first to be built in southwestern Colorado and was built by Mr. Cole's own pattern and ideas; Elmer Peterson of Durango was the contractor. The entrance is through two large iron and plate glass doors (vandalized in the 1990s), and inside on iron brackets, the caskets rest.
