JACKSON, ABNER M., SR., JUDGE - Husband of Sarah Stephens; Father of Dilla Jackson Raymond, Ella Jackson, Frank M. Jackson, George Jackson and Ab Jackson, Jr. - Feb 3, 1824 - Sept 6, 1888

JACKSON, ANNA KAISA JOHNSON DILLON - (Mrs. Ernest Jackson; Formerly Mrs. Peter Dillon); Mother of Carl Hilder, Hilda Caroline and Olga Dillon; Sister of Charles G. Johnson (died 1909) - Aug 16, 1865 - May 10, 1959

JACKSON, ANNE BAUER SAGE - (Mrs. Scot Jackson; Formerly Mrs. Sage); Mother of Suzy Kay Culpepper and Kathi Wade; Daughter of Theodore, Jr. and Gersilda M. Bauer Jennermann - May 21, 1942 - Apr 19, 1982

JACKSON, CHARLES – Suicide - Died Nov 27, 1901 – Charles walked behind the bar in the Anderson & Ekholm Saloon, coolly picked up a 44 caliber revolver, placed the weapon to his head ,and with one well placed shot ended his unhappy existence

JACKSON, CLARENCE VICTOR - Son of Victor and Hilma Johnson Jackson; Brother of Oliver Theodore and Helen Victoria Jackson - Jan 10, 1913 - Jan 20, 1913 - Age 10 Days

JACKSON, ERNEST - Flu - Husband of Anna Kaisa Johnson Dillon; Son of Isaac Jackson - Aug 15, 1886 - Oct 31, 1918

JACKSON, JACK - Died June 26, 1921

JACKSON, JOSEPHINE PAULSON - (Mrs. Fred Lockwood Jackson); Daughter of Gundar Paulson - Mar 18, 1884 - Sept 13, 1947

JACKSON, OLIVER THEODORE - Son of Victor and Hilma Johnson Jackson; Brother of Clarence Victor and Helen Victoria Jackson - Died Nov 5, 1909 - Age 5 Months

JACKSON, PETER - See Isaacson, Nels Peter

JACKSON, ROLAND T. - 1868 – 1907

JAMES, ANNIE - Suicide by Poison - Died Mar 26, 1897 – The unfortunate girl swallowed a two ounce bottle of carbolic acid and died in about three hours.

JAMES, CLAUD - Infant Son of Emerson and Charlotte Nichols James - Died July 25, 1904 - Age 7 Hours

JAMES, INFANT GIRL - Daughter of Emerson and Charlotte Nichols James - Died July 24, 1910

JAMES, ROBERT - Died Oct 26, 1902 - Age 55 Years

JAMES, SAMUEL HENRY - Suicide – Shot through Heart - Husband of Mrs. Emma Warnick Robbins; Step-Father of Andrew Robbins; Son of Samuel and Grace Anthony James; Brother of Sarah James Ching - Apr 20, 1857 - May 28, 1902 – Born in Cornwall

JARAMILLO, AMOS - Veteran World War II - Husband of May Jackson Booker; Father of Colleen, Christine, Cheryl, Amos D. and Dale D. Jaramillo; Step-father of Terry, Sherrie, Chris Dewey and Jody Booker; Son of Francisco and Maria Jaramillo- Jan 31, 1915 - Sept 19, 1981

JARAMILLO, FRANCISCO - Husband of Maria; Father of Amos, Elmer, Levi and Raynel Othioniel Jaramillo and Ferminia (Mrs. Adolphia Roybal), Elisaida (Mrs. Ted Roybal) and Sidella (Mrs. Manuel Cordova) - Died May 25, 1950 - Age 79 Years

JARAMILLO, JUANETTA - Infant Daughter of Peter and Pauline Gonzales Jaramillo - Sept 14, 1931 - Sept 21, 1931 - Age 1 Week

JARAMILLO, MAY E. JACKSON - (Mrs. Amos Jaramillo; Formerly Mrs. Harris Booker); Mother of Terry, Sherrie, Chris Dewey and Jody Booker and Colleen, Christine, Cheryl, Amos D. and Dale D. Jaramillo; Daughter of Chris and Ada May Laverty Jackson - June 13, 1923 or 1924 - Jan 18, 1996

JARAMILLO, RAYNEL OTHIONIEL "RAY" - Husband of Juanita Archuleta; Father of Raynel L. and Kenneth Jaramillo; Son of Francisco (Frank) and Maria Jaramillo; Brother of Amos, Elmer and Levi Jaramillo and Sidella (Mrs. Manuel Cordova), Elisaida (Mrs. Ted Roybal) and Ferminia (Mrs. Adolphia Roybal) - Jan 12, 1917 - Feb 15, 1962

JARDON, INFANT BOY - Son of Alfred Frederick Jardon and Huldah Ann Puckett Jardon (later Stephenson); Brother of Nora Jardon; Grandson of Benjamin Gardner "Pard" and Emeline Holmes Puckett; Great-grandson of Morgan and Susan Whitaker Puckett; Nephew of Elizabeth Puckett Hand, Etta Puckett Neeley, Zerilda Minerva Puckett Copeland, Melissa Belle Puckett Swan, Benjamin Franklin "Frank" and Edwin Walter "Walt" Puckett - June 1, 1881 - June 8, 1881 - Age 1 Week

JAUS, CHRIS - Died June 18, 1922 - Age 78 Years – Chronic Bright’s Disease

JEANETTO - See Gianetto

JEFF, WILLIAM – Mine Explosion - Died Dec 17, 1897 - Age 45 Years

JEFFRIES, LAURA ANN GURULE CHACON - (Mrs. Rick Jeffries; Formerly Mrs. Phil Chacon); Mother of Amanda, Michael and Matthew Chacon; Daughter of Alonzo and Jane Gurule; Sister of Marie Gurule Gallegos, Don, Jimmy, Jerry, Max and Pete Gurule - Oct 30, 1959 - July 12, 1992 – Laurie was killed in a Denver car accident

JENKINS, GWEN ROBERTS JONES - (Mrs. Richard Jenkins; Formerly Mrs. Henry Jones); Mother of Laura Alice Jones Stanger Burnell; Daughter of Owen and Laura Roberts; Sister of Robert W. and Ebenezer L. Roberts - Apr 21, 1856 - Jan 10, 1917 – Born in Barmouth, North Wales

JENKINS, JOHN THOMAS, SR. - Husband of Mary Louise Parmiter; Father of John Thomas Jenkins, Jr. and Thelma Louise Jenkins (Mrs. J.O. Jenkins); Son of William and Mary Irons Jenkins - Dec 19, 1912 - June 10, 1965

JENKINS, RICHARD - Husband of Gwendolyn Roberts Jones Jenkins (formerly Mrs. Henry Jones); Step-father of Laura Jones Stanger Burnell; Son of Daniel Jenkins - 1851 - Jan 23, 1913 – Born in South Wales

JENNINGS, INFANT BOY – Son of Floyd A. and Nina Reed Jennings – Mar 4, 1925 – This little boy died at birth

JEPSON, PETER - Died Mar 21, 1906 - Age 56 Years

JEWELL, JAMES – Snowslide - Died Mar 8, 1878

JEWELL, JAMES – Pneumonia - Died June 4, 1893 - Age 24 Years

JOB, AUGUSTA ORELLA - (Mrs. John Job; Formerly Mrs. Valer and Mrs. Augustine?); Mother of Ernest Valer, Jr. and Elva Job; Daughter of Martin and Marianna Piana Orella; Sister of Joseph and Peter Orella - Feb 3, 1880 - Aug 23, 1919

JOB, ERNEST VALER - See Valer, Ernest - Son of Augusta Orella Job

JOB, JOHN - Also Known as John Jobstraibizer; Husband of Augusta Orella; Father of Elva Job; Step-father of Ernest Valer, Jr.; Son of J. Jobstraibizer - 1875 - Sept 21, 1922

JOBSTRAIBIZER, JOHN - See Job, John

JOHNNY BEHIND THE ROCK - See Williams, John

JOHNSON - Also See Johnston

JOHNSON, ALBERT - Nov 8, 1865 - July 12, 1900

JOHNSON, ALFRED - Son of Johan Jacobson - Oct 31, 1875 - Feb 23, 1906

JOHNSON, ANDREW HUGO – Died 1905 – Husband of Mary (Marie Anna) Hendrickson, Father of Annie (Anna Irene) and sons, Hugo Jrenues, Severin Andrew and Vanner John Johnson, Grandfather of Severin Vanner Johnson, Son of John and Marie Elizabetha Anderson – May 16, 1860 – July 10, 1905

JOHNSON, ANDREW J. - See Johnson, Kopel

JOHNSON, ANNIE - Daughter of Andrew Hugo and Mary Hendrickson Johnson, Sister of Hugo Jrenues, Severin Andrew and Vanner John Johnson - July 11, 1905 - Oct 20, 1905 -Age 3 Months 9 Days

JOHNSON, ANTONE (or August) – 1840 – Mar 9, 1905

JOHNSON, AUGUSTUS (or Antone) - 1840 - Mar 9, 1905

JOHNSON, AUGUST - See Johnson, Antone

JOHNSON, AUGUST - Electrocuted - (Also Referred to as Johnston, Charles) - Died July 22, 1909 - Age 45 Years

JOHNSON, AUGUSTUS CONRAD (also known as Gus Conrad) - Mine Cave-in - Died Aug 28, 1901 - Gust was horribly killed in a cave-in on the fifth level of the North Star Mine on King Solomon Mountain

JOHNSON, BENJAMIN - Cousin of Alfred and John Benson - April 1879 - May 3, 1915

JOHNSON, CARL O. - Mill Accident - Husband of Olga Maria Johannesdotter; Son of Gus and Helen Anders Johnson; Brother-in-law of John Benson, Anton and Theodor Johannesson and of Nora, Hilda, Charlotta and Agneta Johannesdotter - Oct 25, 1880 - Nov 14, 1909

JOHNSON, CARL – Flu - Died Oct 24, 1918

JOHNSON, CHARLES - Died Apr 3, 1896 – Born in Sweden

JOHNSON, CHARLES W. - June 12, 1873 - June 10, 1929

JOHNSON, CLAY - See Johnston, H. Clay

JOHNSON, EDWARD - Flu - Husband of Hulda Backman; Father of Raymond Johnson; Son of James and Kristina Peterson; Brother of Gus S. Johnson- Mar 11, 1884 - Nov 6, 1918

JOHNSON, ERIC - Father of Ole Johnson; Son of John and Lena Matford Johnson - Died Apr 21, 1915 - Age 50 Years

JOHNSON, FANNIE - Mother of George Williams - 1885 - Oct 18, 1915
JOHNSON, FRED A. - Died Oct 26, 1906 - Fred, a miner at the Silver Lake Mine, died of meningitis and alcoholism
JOHNSON, FRED A. - Son of John Johnson - Died Aug 25, 1927 - Age 37 Years - Fred died of bronchial pneumonia
JOHNSON, GUS B. - Son of Johannes Johnson - 1875 - Dec 4, 1915 –
JOHNSON, GUS – Flu - Died Oct 26, 1918
JOHNSON, HARRY C. – Explosion - Died Dec 24, 1891
JOHNSON, HJALMER - Mine Cave-in - Died Mar 2, 1898 - Age 30 Years
JOHNSON, JOHN - Fell from Tram Bucket - Died Nov 15, 1904 - Age 39 Years - John, one of the linemen on the Sunnyside tram, was found in the slide rock below the tram line, a mangled corpse
JOHNSON, JOHN A. "ONION NOSE" - Son of Johannes Bengston Johnson; Brother of Ben Johnson; Uncle of Ada C. and Iver B. Johnson - Feb 24, 1872 - Aug 21, 1935 – Born in Sweden; died during heart attack on way to hospital
JOHNSON, JOSEPH - Suffocated in Ore Bin - Son of John Johnson - Mar 5, 1891 - Oct 18, 1913 - Age 22 Years - Born in Varmland, Sweden – Joe was trying to loosen some ore which was frozen in the bin at the head of the tram at the Iowa Tiger Mine. Suddenly, the entire mass slid and covered him under several feet of ore. ..."Only a miner, killed in a breath, only a working man, gone to his death; only a grave 'neath a murmuring pine, Joe, in his twenties, killed in a mine."
JOHNSON, KOPEL "KOP" or ANDREW J. - Mine Cave-in - Son of John Johnson - Died Jan 21, 1910 - Age 34 Years - While at work in one of the stopes of the Gold King Mine, Johnson was caught and buried beneath a sudden cave-in of rock.
JOHNSON, LOUIS "DUTCH" - Died May 20, 1907 - Age 40 Years
JOHNSON, LOUIS M. - Son of John and Annie Anderson Pierson; Brother of Justina Johnson Trembath - Mar 24, 1870 - May 14, 1911
JOHNSON, MOREHEAD - See Morehead, Johnson - His name was most often found with "Morehead" as his last name.
JOHNSON, NELS ALGOT PAUL - Son of Nels Gustaf "Gus" and Anna Nelson Johnson - Feb 10, 1915 - Dec 10, 1915 - Age 10 Months
JOHNSON, OLAF H. - Nov 11, 1866 - Mar 2, 1896 - His tombstone states he was born in Sweden and was killed at the Iowa Mine
JOHNSON, OLGA MARIA JOHANNESDOTTER - (Mrs. Carl O. Johnson) - Daughter of Johannes Tolleson and Maria Katrina Nilsdotter; Sister of Hilda Johannesdotter Olsson - Sept 10, 1875 or July 4, 1887 (sources differed) - Apr 30, 1905 - Olga died at her home, corner of 13th and Snowden, of septic peritonitis
JOHNSON, PATSY (ANGENETTE WASSON) – Prostitute - 1881 - June 7, 1903
JOHNSON, PAULINE LOUISE VAN SLYCK - Childbirth - (Mrs. Carl Johnson); Mother of Mary Pauline and Barent Johnson; Daughter of Barent and Mary Pauline Grebles Van Slyck; Granddaughter of Alfred and Louisa Bernier Grebles- 1889 - May 12, 1921
JOHNSON, PETE M. - 1861 - May 17, 1916
JOHNSON, RASMUS – Flu - Died Oct 25, 1918 - Rasmus, another flu victim, died at about 10:00 p.m. after being deathly sick six days and nights.
JOHNSON, SWAN J. - Son of John and Marie Swanson Johnson; Brother of J. Albin Johnson - Oct 9, 1869 - Dec 29, 1912
JOHNSON, VIRGUS - Flu - This name appeared in an early list of flu dead, but not in later corrected lists.
JOHNSON, WILLIAM E. "FATTY" - Veteran Civil War - Died Aug 18, 1910 - Age 72 Years
JOHNSON, WILLIAM ELMER, JR. - Son of William Elmer, Sr. and Ruth Bradley Johnson - May 17, 1930 - May 18, 1930
JOHNSTON - Also See Johnson
JOHNSTON, CHARLES - See Johnson, August
JOHNSTON, CLAY - See Johnston, Thomas Henry Clay
JOHNSTON, JOHN - Died Oct 19, 1883
JOHNSTON, MARY (MAY) HANNAH GUIHEN - (Mrs. Thomas Henry Clay Johnston) - Feb 12, 1880 - Feb 9, 1934
JOHNSTON, THOMAS HENRY CLAY - Husband of May Hannah Guihen - Died Aug 5, 1937

JONES, AGNES DEE MALCOLM - (Mrs. Finney Jones); Mother of Doris Lenore Jones Shepherd Hite, Malcolm "Mickey" Duncan Jones and Stewart McFarland Jones; Daughter of Mrs. Agnes Malcolm; Sister of Christina "Chrissy" Malcolm (Mrs. Dan Sheahan), Mary Malcolm (Mrs. McFarland), William Malcolm, Archie Malcolm and John D. Malcolm - Jan 2, 1865 - Nov 25, 1935

JONES, BOB - Died Oct 26, 1902 - Age 55 Years

JONES, DAVID F. - Flu - Nov 18, 1883 - Oct 31, 1918

JONES, DAVID REESE, JR. - Age 4 Days - Son of David Reese Jones, Sr. and May Lewis Jones; Brother of Margaret Ann, Thomas Lewis and Elizabeth Jones; Grandson of David and Mary Ann Mason Lewis - Aug 15, 1910 - Aug 19, 1910

JONES, DAVID REESE, SR. - Husband of May Lewis (later Hughes); Father of Elizabeth, David Reese Jr., Margaret Ann and Thomas Lewis Jones - Sept 13, 1871 - Aug 5, 1915

JONES, ELIZABETH JANE BALMFIELD "BESSIE" - (Mrs. William Jones); Mother of Willie J., Frederick Thomas and Millie Jones and Mary Ann Jones Osgood; Daughter of John Cox Balmfield - Dec 2, 1855 - Apr 6, 1923

JONES, FINNEY - Husband of Agnes Dee Malcolm; Father of Doris Lenore, Malcolm Duncan "Mickey" and Stewart McFarland Jones - Oct 17, 1854 - Mar 20, 1918

JONES, FREDERICK THOMAS "FRED" - Son of William and Bessie Balmfield Jones; Brother of William J. "Willie" Jones and Mary Ann Jones Osgood; Half-brother of Mrs. Millie Ross - June 26, 1889 - July 27, 1945

JONES, HARRY F. - 1884 - 1903 - Age 19 Years

JONES, HENRY - Husband of Gwendolyn Roberts Jones (later Jenkins); Father of Laura Alice Jones Stanger Burnell; Brother of John Jones - Oct 15, 1850 - July 13, 1897 - The Welsh inscription on his marker reads "Dyma Fan Fechan Ei Fedd", which translates as "This is the small place of his grave"

JONES, JOHN - Brother of Henry Jones; Uncle of Laura Burnell - Died Dec 16, 1915 - Age 75 Years

JONES, JOHN D. "BUNKER HILL" - Died Aug 16, 1894 - Age 49 Years

JONES (or McJONES), JOSEPH - Son of Evan and Margaret Jones; Relative of Henry Jones - Died Sept 29, 1889 - Age 32 Years

JONES, LOUISA - (Mrs. W.W. Jones) - 1861 - Aug 31, 1892 - Inscription on tombstone reads "Killed (at) Yankee Girl Mine August 31, 1892" and a Welsh inscription which translates to "In loving memory of Louisa, dear wife of W.W. Jones, Yankee Girl Mine, Colorado, formerly of Coedpoeth, who died August 31st 1892, aged 31.

JONES, MARGARET ANN - Daughter of David R. and May S. Lewis Jones; Brother of Thomas Lewis, David Reese, Jr. and Margaret Ann Jones and Elizabeth Jones (later Wyman); Granddaughter of David and Mary Ann Mason Lewis - Aug 6, 1906 - Apr 12, 1909 - Age 2-1/2 Years

JONES, MARY ANN - (Mrs. Thomas Jones) - Mother of Gertie and Celia Hurley- 1845 - July 30, 1890

JONES, MORGAN - Son of Thomas and Sarah Morgan Jones - 1856 - Nov 27, 1902

JONES, ROBERT ORRIN - Son of George and Evangeline MacAloney Jones - Died Aug 11, 1936 - Age 3 Hours

JONES, THOMAS - See James, Robert

JONES, THOMAS LEWIS - Son of David Reese, Sr. and May S. Lewis Jones; Brother of David Reese, Jr., Margaret Ann and Elizabeth Jones; Grandson of David and Mary Ann Mason Lewis - May 18, 1903 - May 21, 1912 - Age 9 Years - Tommy was the firstborn of David and May, and their third child to be touched by the hand of death within three years.

JONES, WALTER BYRON - Husband of Aileen McLaughlin; Father of Byron, Terry and Richard Jones and Patricia Jones Reber; Son of Byron Hill Jones and Nettie Levanche Triplett Quarles Seip Jones Newman; Brother of Edrie Ella Jones Hook, Dona June Jones Dodd Hillewart and Nettie Jones Hitti Ball; Half-brother of Chrystal Quarles Morgan, George Seip, Thelma Gertrude Seip DeRosa Newton, Violet Seip Bowman and John F. "Jack" Newman, Jr.; Grandson of George W. and Tempie Leach Garza Triplett - Aug 15, 1911 - May 14, 1993

JONES, WILLIAM - Suicide by Poison - Husband of Elizabeth "Bessie" Balmfield; Father of Fred Thomas and William J. "Willie" Jones and Mary Ann Jones Osgood; Step-father of Millie Ross; Brother of Charles E. Jones - Apr 17, 1854 - Oct 7, 1936

JONES, WILLIAM B. - Son of Griffith Jones - Died June 6, 1908

JONES, WILLIAM J. "WILLIE" - Murdered - Son of William and Elizabeth "Bessie" Balmfield Jones; Brother of Frederick Thomas "Freddie" Jones and Mary Ann Jones Osgood; Half-brother of Millie Ross; Uncle of Everett Osgood; Nephew of Charles E. Jones - Jan 31, 1887 - Aug 11, 1928

JONSSON – See **HOLMGRAIN** (name was changed in America)

JORDAN - See Jardon

JOSLIN (or JOSLYN), CHARLES - Died May 16, 1887 - Age 26 Years

JUNE, LESLIE - Brother of W.E. and Francis June; Uncle of Mrs. Grace June Rector - Mar 3, 1860 - June 16, 1932

JURICH, PAUL - Son of Max Jurich (or Jursh); Cousin of Mark Kullaik - 1876 - Dec 29, 1915
