KAINE - See Caine, Kane

KALINA, DAN – Father of Kathilynn Kalina; Brother of David Kalina; Son of Joseph and Florence Kalina – Died May 2, 1998 – Age 49 Years

KALTENBACHER, JOSEPH -His name was spelled in various ways) - Died June 20, 1910 - Age 55 Years

KANE - Also spelled Cain, Caine, Cane, Kaine, Koehn

KANE, JAMES "JIM" – Snowslide - 1849 - Jan 27, 1914 – Died in his cabin near the Shenandoah Mine trail when the mountainside of snow broke loose and crushed him

KANE, JOHN "BO" - 1866 - Oct 20, 1914

KANE, JOHN CADUC - Confederate Veteran Civil War - Husband of Sarah Agnes Evans Ephland - Sept 9, 1846 - May 17, 1901

KANE, SARAH AGNES EVANS EPHLAND - (Mrs. John Caduc Kane); Daughter of James and Mariam Helms Evans; Sister of Ida, Rebecca (Adams), Susan (Hoggatt, Josephine (Adams), Milton, James, Walter, D.J., T.D., Harry Evans - Feb 29, 1844 - Aug 3, 1906

KANE, SARAH ELIZABETH - See Caine, Sarah M.

KATHERINE, MARY - Stone placed in 2003

KATTENBACHER - See Kaltenbacher

KATZ, RICHARD - Husband of Susan; Father of Kristen and Bo Katz - May 26, 1944 - Dec 31, 1985

KAUTH, ANTON "ANDY" - Son of Barbara Link Kauth; Brother of C. Kauth; Uncle of Emma Kauth - Sept 15, 1848 - July 25, 1911

KAWALSKI - See Kowalski

KEAN, HORACE JOSEPH BLACKBURN - Son of Mr. And Mrs. Horace P. Kean – May 15, 1888 – Jan 29, 1889 – Age 8 Months 14 Days – “There are loved ones lost! There are little graves, In the distant dell, 'neath protecting trees, Where the streamlet winds and the violet waves, And the grasses sway to the singing breeze. And we mourn for the pressure of tender lips, And the light of eyes darkened in death's eclipse.”

KEARNEY - See Carney

KEATON, ELLA "ROXY" - (or Keeton, Ellen) – Prostitute - Died May 22, 1901 - Age 40 Years - Ella, known as “Roxy” in Blair Street circles, was one of the poor unfortunate girls who worked as a prostitute at Luke's Dance Hall in Silverton

KEEGAN, ELLEN, MRS. - Mother of James Keegan, Mrs. Robert Morrison, Mrs. James Fitzgerald; Mother-in-law of Louise Kindsvogel Keegan- Died Dec 5, 1891 - Age 63 Years

KEEGAN, LOUISE KINDSVOGEL and Baby - (Mrs. James Keegan) - 1863 - Sept 22, 1891

KEETON, ELLEN - See Keaton, Ella

KELBURG - See Charlberg

KELLETT, SOLOMON "SOL" – Snowslide - 1852 - Jan 30, 1883

KELLEY - See Kelly - As these names were often spelled interchangeably, all are listed in this work as "Kelly", to permit ease of comparison.

KELLY, EDWARD - Ore Chute Accident - Died Nov 6, 1903 - Age 36 Years

KELLY, JAMES - See O'Kelly, James

KELLY, JOSEPH PATRICK "BOXCAR" - Aug 16, 1892 - Dec 25, 1944 - Age 52 - Boxcar died of alcoholism at 1134 Blair Street

KELLY, THE FIDDLER - (Also known as Kelly, the Drunken Musician) - Died Oct 2, 1883 - Kelly, the drunken musician, died on a Tuesday night in the poor house.

KELLY, THOMAS - Died Nov 24, 1909 - Tom died of delirium tremens and lobar pneumonia

KEMPER, FRED - Broken Back - Died May 5, 1897

KEMPER, PERCY LEE - Explosion - Husband of Annette; Son of E.O. Kemper - July 24, 1868 - June 14, 1903

KENNEDY, HUGH - Died Oct 10, 1910 - Age 40 Years

KENNEDY, PATRICK - Brother of John Kennedy - Mar 18, 1868 - Apr 13, 1890

KENNEDY, WILLIAM P. - Buried at Schneider's Ten Mile House - Died Sept 18, 1881

KENSIG, FRED - Died Sept 18, 1878

KEPFERLE, CHARLES WILLIAM - Brother of George Royal and Harry Kepferle - Aug 23, 1881 - Dec 17, 1935

KERMODE, INFANT BOY - Son of Richard C. "Dick" and Mrs. Kermode - Died Oct 12, 1890 – Age 2 Months

KERNAN, INFANT TWIN GIRL - Daughter of James and Mrs. Kernan - Nov 28, 1901 - Nov 29, 1901 - Age 1 Day

KID THOMAS - See Copper Colored Kid

KILDEY, JOHN "SHORTY" - Died Mar 1, 1899 - Age 36 Years

KILDUFF, FRANK - Died Dec 28, 1908

KIMBALL, ALICE MARIAN HENDRICKSON - Died 1948 - (Mrs. Orlo Davies Kimball); Mother of Robert Bruce and Tom Orlo Kimball; Daughter of Simeon P. Hendrickson and Ellen Louise Wilkinson Hendrickson; Sister of Ida Hendrickson Hanna and Laura Hendrickson Arrington; Half-Sister of Bert Wilkinson and Flora Wilkinson (Mrs. Orville Dewey) Pyle - Nov 1877 - Aug 27, 1948

KIMBALL, ORLO DAVIES - Husband of Alice Marian Hendrickson; Father of Tom Orlo and Robert Bruce Kimball - Apr 9, 1852 - Mar 28, 1917

KIMBALL, ROBERT BRUCE - Son of Orlo D. and Alice Hendrickson Kimball; Brother of Tom Orlo Kimball; Grandson of Simeon P. and Louise Wilkinson Hendrickson – 1904 - July 12, 1925

KING, DAVID "B.O. PLENTY" - Son of John H. "Jack" and Annie M. Kirk King - Mar 3, 1883 - Jan 1, 1960

KINNEY, MABEL L. (BRITON?) - Scarlet Fever, Meningitis - Adopted Daughter of Willis Z. and Mary E. Wirtzenberger Kinney - Jan 14, 1894 - Feb 1, 1900

KINSELLA, JAMES - Brother of P.R. Kinsella - Died Apr 29, 1907 - Age 48 Years

KINTERKNECHT, ELLA B. – 9-17-1911 – 3-8-2006

KINTERKNECHT, JAKE JOE - Husband of Mrs. Ella Brown; Son of Nick and Anna Gerstner Kinterknecht; Brother of Joseph John, Pete J., Manuel K. Kinterknecht and Mary Kinterknecht, Ruby Unrein (later Schurr), Rose Kramer - 1909 - Oct 21, 1962

KINTERKNECHT, LOIS MARIE CARVER - Car Wreck - (Mrs. Pete J. Kinterknecht); Mother of Shirley Ann and Terry Pete Kinterknecht; Daughter of James and Retta M. Davis Carver; Sister of Bill, Ross, Paul, James and Kay Slade, Mrs. Raymond Pierce, Lillian Barraclough and Mrs. Everett Stevens - Mar 18, 1929 - May 26, 1954

KIPP, JOHN G. - Uncle of M.W. Kipp - Died Feb 1, 1903 - John, a carpenter who was about 54 years old, had been badly injured on January 18th when he fell twenty feet from a scaffold while working on his new hotel building at Red Mountain

KLANG, EMIL - July 31 1876 - Jan 13, 1930

KLEMENTS, JOHN LEWIS, SR. - Husband of Mary Gertrude Drobnick; Father of John Lewis, Jr., William Joseph "Billy", Norman James "Bud" and Carolyn Klements; Brother of Joe Klements, Lillian Klements MacIntosh, Annie Klements Kolar Savich and Mary Klements Langley; Half-brother of Martin Slabonick, Jr.; Son of John Klements and Anna Klepper Klements (later Slabonick) - Oct 14, 1896 - Oct 27, 1948

KLEMENTS, JOSEPH - Son of John Klements and Anna Klepper Klements (later Slabonick); Brother of Annie Klements (later Kolar, Savich), Mary Klements (later Langley), Lillie Klements (married MacIntosh) and John L. Klements; Half-brother of Martin Slabonick, Jr. - Feb 2, 1902 - Nov 28, 1937

KLEMENTS, MARY GERTRUDE DROBNICK - (Mrs. John L. Klements, Sr.); Mother of John Lewis, Jr., William Joseph "Billy", Norman James "Bud" and Carolyn Klements; Daughter of John and Anna Drobnick; Sister of Tony, Louis R. and John Drobnick and Victoria Drobnick Prince Grande - Mar 25, 1903 - Apr 17, 1988

KLINE, CHARLES "CHARLEY" - Oct 8, 1856 - Apr 13, 1943

KLING, ISAAC "IKE" - Died April 22, 1919 - Age 68 Years

KLOSTER, JOHN N. - Husband of Mary A. Alich (or Valich) - Jan 3, 1859 - Dec 15, 1927

KLOSTER, MARY A. ALICH (or VALICH) - (Mrs. John N. Kloster); Daughter of John Adam and Margaret Mueller Valich Kloster - Sept 7, 1858 - Dec 4, 1945

KLUSMAN, JOHN – Snowslide - Died Feb 12, 1879 - John was killed at the Highland Mary Mine as he was attempting to rescue three other men lost in an earlier slide

KNEER, RICHARD – Murdered - May 14, 1861 - Aug 20, 1911

KNEZ, KARL - Nov 2, 1888 - Feb 1, 1933

KNOLL, JOHN W. - Son of John Knoll, Sr.; Father of Frank Knoll and Mrs. C.Z. Swallow - Oct 22, 1858 - May 1, 1932

KNOWLTON, HUGH STANLEY "JEW" - Explosion - Son of Harry and Blanche Norrea Knowlton -

Veteran World War II - Jan 11, 1904 - Sept 22, 1946

KNOWLTON, VERA MAY - Daughter of Wright H. and Brintha May Knowlton - May 1, 1904 - Mar 14, 1905 - Age 10 Months

KOCEVAR - See Kochevar

KOCH, GEORGE - 1854 - Aug 26, 1918

KOCHEVAR, JACK – Murdered - Son of Mativi and Nezan Tekovec Kochevar; Brother of Matt Kochevar; Uncle of Louis Kochevar - 1868 - Feb 21, 1914

KOCHEVAR, LOUIS - Flu - Son of Matt and Mary Starlaj Kochevar; Nephew of Jack Kochevar - May 29, 1887 - Oct 26, 1918

KOCHEVAR, MATT - Husband of Mary Starlaj; Father of Louis Kochevar and a Daughter; Son of Mativi and Nezan Tekovec Kochevar; Brother of Jack Kochevar - 1857 - Jan 3, 1917

KOEHLER, HAROLD - Scarlet Fever - Son of Frederick William "Billy" and Mary Ellen Opey Koehler; Brother of Burne, Minnie, J. Frank, Billy, Jr., Irene, Silver and Another, Name Unknown - Sept 28, 1899 - Oct 14, 1901 - Age 2 Years

KOEHLER, J. FRANK - Measles - Son of Frederick William, Sr. "Billy" and M. Ellen Opey Koehler; Brother of Burne, Minnie, Billy, Jr., Irene, Silver, Harold and Another, Name Unknown – Mar 17, 1885 - Aug 18, 1891 - For the second time in less than two weeks, death visited the Koehler family and took away a precious child

KOEHLER, WILHEMINA "MINNIE" - Measles - Daughter of Frederick William, Sr., "Billy" and Mary Ellen (called Ellen) Opey Koehler; Sister of Burne, J. Frank, Billy, Jr., Irene, Silver, Harold and Another, Name Unknown - May 26, 1883 - Aug 5, 1891 - Age 8 Years

KOEHN - See Caine, Kane

KOENNEKER, CHARLES C. "CHARLEY" - Died Apr 1, 1923 - Age 70 Years

KOESTLE - See Castle

KOLAR, JOHNNY MIKE - Son of Mike Kolar and Annie Klements Kolar (later Savich); Brother of Mary Elizabeth "Mitzi" Kolar (Wheeler); Half-brother of Helen Ruby Savich (Heidy), Lillie Ann Savich (Pergola), Margaret Jane Savich (Probst) and Peter Thomas "Tom" Savich - Nov 7, 1911 - Jan 6, 1933

KOLAR, MIKE - Husband of Annie Klements Kolar (later Savich); Father of Johnny Mike and Mary Elizabeth "Mitzi" Kolar - Sept 27, 1882 - Aug 21, 1920

KOOPMAN, ROBERT ALAN "BOB" - Mar 20, 1953 - Dec 14, 1977

KOVACEVIC, BOSCO - Flu - Son of Pero and Milica Kovacevic - 1889 - Oct 20, 1918

KOWALSKI, WILLIAM - Mine Cave-in - Died June 27, 1929 - Age 28 Years

KRAMER, INFANT GIRL - Daughter of C.H.H. and Ellen Lynch Kramer - June 22, 1886 - This little girl, first child of Charles and Ellen, was stillborn

KRAMER, JACK - Died in a Privy - Died July 7, 1910 - Age 55 Years

KREGER, OTTO - Suicide - Shot Himself in Forehead – Husband of Lizzie Schreiber - Apr 1870 - Dec 5, 1895

KRISTO, TONY - 1890 - Mar 14, 1930 - Age 39 Years

KRISTOFFERSON, VICTOR EMANUEL - (also spelled CHRISTOFFERSON) – Crushed in Gold King Mine - Died Jan 17, 1907 - Age 43 Years

KRIVANEK (Austrian spelling) - See Kriwanek (German, American spelling)

KRIWANEK, FRANZ FERDINAND - Suicide - Husband of Hermine Habenreich; Father of Elizabeth Chapman, Kristina Faldyn, Eva Louise Debolt - May 1, 1920 - July 6, 1994 – Born in Worschack, Austria

KRIWANEK, HERMINE - (Mrs. Franz Kriwanek); Mother of Elizabeth, Kristina and Eva Kriwanek - Dec 16, 1920 - July 2, 1992

KUHLMAN, KIMBERLY ANN - Daughter of Ernie and Judy R. Garcia Kuhlman - Apr 15, 1967 - Aug 13, 1977 - Age 10 Years

KUHN, RUSSELL JACK – March 22, 1921 – Feb 18, 2004 - Son of William and Martha Kuhn; Father of Mitchell Kuhn

KUIVILA, JOHN "CHRISTMAS TREE JOHN" - 1884 - Dec 30, 1939 – Born in Finland

KUNKLE, MABEL PEARL - Daughter of William A. and Mabel Thomas Kunkle - May 30, 1905 - June 11, 1905 - Age 12 Days
