**LACEY (LACY), GROVER W.** - Mill Accident - Husband of Arta Boden (later Saenger); Father of Dorothy Winifred Lacey(Lacy); Son of James O. and Esther Saylor Lacey(Lacy); Brother of Milton, Byron and Steve Lacey (Lacy) - Feb 4, 1887 - Nov 12, 1910

**LADORTE** - See Laporte

**LAKE, RICHARD** - Son of Richard Lake, Sr. - Died Feb 23, 1912 - Age 73 Years

**LAMBERT, JAMES WILBER** - Son of Mr. and Mrs. Richard Lambert; Grandson of John and Miranda Guy Lambert; Great-Grandson of Hugh, Sr. and Candacy Messer Lambert (perhaps) - April 20, 1901 - Aug 20, 1902 - Age 1 Year 4 Months

**LAMBERT, JOHN L.** - Former Husband of Miranda Guy; Son of Hugh and Candacy Messer Lambert - Oct 1, 1844 - Oct 4, 1902

**LAMBERT, MIRANDA JANE GUY** - (Formerly Mrs. John L. Lambert) - Died Feb 22, 1933 - Age 84 Years

**LAMBERT, SENA** - Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John L. Lambert - Died Mar 9, 1889

**LANDRY, ARTHUR** - Mine Cave-in - Son of George Landry, Sr. and Vitalin Hebert (or Herbert or Herbet) Landry; Brother of Joseph and George Thomas Landry - Dec 2, 1865 - Nov 24, 1916

**LANDRY, DELVINA ROBILLARD** - (Her first name was also referred to as Selvina and Della) (Mrs. George Thomas Landry); Mother of George Joseph, Bertha Bridget, Zeluma and Della Eugena Landry; Daughter of Joseph Robillard - Aug 26, 1876 - Apr 25, 1911

**LANDRY, JOSEPH** - Brother of Arthur and George Landry - 1871 - Oct 21, 1906

**LANE, GORDON WILLIAM** - Jan 28, 1949 - June 6-2004 - Father of Paul Lane; Son of William T. Lane and Junebelle Anna Damschroder Thomas Lane ScheerAdee

**LANG, WILLIAM "BILLY** - See Long, William

**LANGHURST, CHARLES HENRY** - Son of Henry and Lena Henrietta Connell Langhurst; Brother of William and Robert Raymond Langhurst - May 30, 1906 - Jan 25, 1907 - Age 7 Months - The angel of death hovered over the happy home of Henry and Lena then stole away their darling infant son.

**LANGOLF, GEORGE EDWARD "HIGH POCKETS"** - Possible Suicide - Dynamite Explosion- Son of Louis Langolf and Katherine Wittman Langolf (later Luttrell); Brother of John Theodore and Lillian Langolf; Former Husband of Frances V. Tabor - 1871 - June 21, 1933

**LANGOLF, JOHN THEODORE** - Son of Louis and Katherine Wittman Langolf; Brother of George Edward "High Pockets" Langolf and Lillian Langolf Crosby - 1869 - Mar 1914

**LAPORTE, ARTHUR LOYAL "SHORTY"** - Son of James D. and Hattie Roberts LaPorte - Nov 11, 1903 - Oct 5, 1934

**LARSON, ADELINA RACHEL MORETTI** - Died 2008 - Wife of Clarence Leslie "Les" Larson; Mother of Loretta Larson (Oldfield), Sharon Larson (Krumpholz) and Kenneth Eugene Larson; Daughter of Felix Moretti and Lena Cura Moretti; Sister of Felix Moretti and Mary Lorraine Moretti Andersen; Granddaughter of John and Petronille Ferando Cura - Jan 18, 1921 - May 2, 2008 - Age 87 Years

**LARSON, CHARLES AUGUST** - Husband of Ida Matilda Hall; Father of Carl A. Larson; Step-father of Edwin Adelbert Nelson Larson - Jan 22, 1875 - Nov 4, 1935

**LARSON, CLARENCE LESLIE** - Husband of Adelina Rachel Moretti; Father of Kenneth Eugene, Loretta Kay and Sharon Leslie Larson; Son of Erick John and Florence Catherine Samuelson Larson - Apr 2, 1912 - Sept 7, 1966

**LARSON, ELSIE** - Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Andrew Larson - Aug 1898 - Apr 24, 1900

**LARSON, EMIL** - Died Aug 18, 1907 - Age 37 Years

**LAWRENCE, MIKE** - Died Sept 26, 1998

**LEAHY, MICHAEL** - Died Feb 11, 1891 - Age 45 Years

**LEE, CHARLES M.** - Snowslide - (His Norwegian name: **Karenius Martinussen Botillen**); Husband of

Clara Nystrom (later Celien); Father of Mamie Celie Lee (Marion Celia Lee; married Berg); Brother of Oline Kristine Botillen, Anna Botillen, Martin Lee, Ole M. Lee, Marius (Moris) Lee, Torvald Botillen (Torvald's grandson, Odd Heggelund of Lovenstad, Norway, furnished much family information) - Feb 4, 1854 - Jan 4, 1896 - Charles was buried 10 days in the avalanche's icy embrace before being dug out

**LEE, J.C** - Died Sept 3, 1902 - Age 40 Years

**LEEDOM, KATHRYN ADRIANSON WILSON RICHERSON** - Daughter of Oscar Carl and Josephine Hughes Adrianson; Sister of Helen Irene and Anna Louise Adrianson Farrell; Granddaughter of Emma Adrianson and Ida Hughes - The tombstone is inscribed: "*Cast my ashes to the wild, wild wind, that they may rest where the wild flowers grow.*" - Aug 8, 1916 - June 14, 2002

**LEONARD, FRANKIE** - Flu - Daughter of Charles Augustus and Mary Belle Harwood Leonard; Sister of Marion Belle Leonard (later Chipman); Granddaughter of Ben and Sarah Spillman Harwood - Dec 23, 1901 - Nov 8, 1918 - Age 16 Years

**LEONARD, MARY BELLE HARWOOD** - (Mrs. Charles Augustus Leonard); Mother of Marion Belle Leonard (later Chipman) and Frankie Leonard; Daughter of Ben and Sarah Elizabeth Spillman Harwood; Sister of Frank Harwood and Barbara May Harwood Doud - Feb 21, 1872 - Sept 28, 1908

**LEONESE, GELINDO** - Mine Explosion - Died Mar 7, 1896

**LEPKIN, CARL OSKAR** - Son of John and Anna Gustafson Lepkin; Brother of John Lepkin - April 9, 1876 - Dec 16, 1911

**LEROY, LEONARD** - Typhoid Fever - Husband of Katherine - Feb 7, 1877 - Sept 4, 1917

**LEROY, LOUISE** - Died May 11, 1893 - The very brief notice of her death read: "Died at Silverton, Colorado, San Juan County, May 11, 1893, Louise Leroy, of consumption

**LESTER, MRS. WILLIAM** - Died Sept 11, 1893

**LESTER, WILLIAM HENRY "HARRY"** - Died Nov 9, 1887

**LEVEQUE, LOUIS, MRS.** - Carriage Accident - Died Aug 29, 1895

**LEWIS, CARRIE FRANCES CLARK DAVIS** - Died in Snowslide with Granddaughter - Mother of Frances Davis Schnee; Grandmother of Carrie Frances Schnee; Daughter of Robert Clark - Dec 21, 1865 - Mar 11, 1911

**LEWIS, J. J.** - (See Lewis, John J.)

**LEWIS, JAMES** - Died Nov 14, 1912 - Age 55 Years

**LEWIS, JOHN DANIEL** - Snowslide - Brother of David Llewelyn "Dai" Lewis and Morgan Lewis and others - Born at Penrhiw, Salem, Aberystwyth, County of Cardigan, Wales, United Kingdom - Apr 1867 - Feb 16, 1900

**LEWIS, JOHN J. "JACK"** - Brother of David Lewis - Died Jan 7 or 9, 1895 - Age 34 Years

**LEWIS, JOSEPH ABE** - Husband of Martha Clark; Father of Joe and William Lewis; Son of Lydia Whitney (buried at Cedar Hill, New Mexico Cemetery) - Mar 10, 1879 - June 23, 1968

**LEWIS, MICKEY WHITE** - Prostitute - 1885 - Apr 27, 1925

**LEWIS, NETTIE** - Died 1889 - Suicide by Poison - Prostitute - Died July 14, 1889 - A sad case of suicide by poisoning occurred at Minnie Strong's place on a Sunday night

**LIBBEY, FRANK** - See Sibley, Frank

**LIBON, PETER JOHN** - See Per Lifbom - Mine Accident - Son of Hans and Alma Engberg Libon - Died Mar 16, 1909 - Age 36 Years

**LICHT, FRANCES HELEN "FRANKIE"** - Daughter of Mrs. Helen Licht - Oct 5, 1947 - July 21, 1974

**LIFBOM, PER** - See Peter John Libon

**LILLQUIST, GEORGE** - Died Sept 10, 1924 - Age 35 Years

**LILSOLE, TONY** - Flu - Also Identified as Tony Serasoli - Died Oct 19, 1918 - Age 28 Years

**LIND, JOHN LEO** (spelled Lindstrom in Sweden) - Husband of Ellen Marie Ferguson (Swedish spelling Fogerstrom); Father of Edgar L., Jennie, Margurite, Olga and Eva Lind - August 28, 1866 - Sept 22, 1935

**LINDBERG, OSCAR E.** - Nov 24, 1885 - Jan 8, 1940

**LINDSAY** - See Lindsey

**LINDSEY, GORDON** - Died about 1985 - His ashes were scattered in the Animas Canyon near Elk Park in August 1985.

**LINDSEY, GORDON, MRS.** - Date of death was before 1985 - After her death in Philadelphia, her husband scattered her ashes in the Animas Canyon near Elk Park

**LINDSEY, INFANT** - Child of George C. and Kate B. Lindsey - Died Apr 11, 1883

**LOBACK, LEWIS EMERSON "LOUIE"** - Husband of Mary; Father of Helen; Son of Lewis and Grace Woods Loback - Mar 1, 1902 - Apr 24, 1958  
**LOCKE, JOHN** - Husband of Sandra; Brother of Ric and Sam Locke - Died April 2001  
**LOCKETT, ED** – Negro - Died May 21, 1912 - Age 36 Years  
**LOCKHART, OLIVER W. "OLLIE"** - Husband of Bertha Darrow (later Annear); Father of Oliver Andrew Lockhart; Grandfather of Oliver Annear Lockhart; Son of Captain Andrew and Annie Wallace Lockhart - Nov 17, 1854 - Apr 13, 1902  
**LOFGREN, LARS W.** - Explosion with Patrick Crane and Percy Kemper; Husband of Anna; Son of A.G. Lofgren - Apr 29, 1867 - June 14, 1903 - On a Sunday night one of the worst mine accidents in the history of the county occurred near Eureka. The full facts of the dreadful and appalling catastrophe would never be definitely known, as no one was left to tell the tale.  
**LOFTUS, JOHN** - Murdered - Son of John and Mary Ferguson Loftus; Cousin of Anthony Crane - Died Oct 1, 1904 - Age 29 Years  
**LOFTUS, MAY GIBSON** - (Mrs. William Loftus); Mother of Joseph William Loftus; Daughter of William Anson and Laura May Patton Gibson - Died Apr 1, 1896  
**LOGAN** - Three Logan brothers, David M., George C. and William Davidson, the sons of David and Agnes Mathieson Logan, were early Silverton settlers. There are two Logan family plots at Hillside.  
**LOGAN, AGNES J.** - Daughter of George C. and Mary Breen Logan - Died Apr 5 or Apr 22, 1893 - Age 17 Days  
**LOGAN, ALVA GEORGE** – Accidentally Shot - Son of William Davidson and Mary Isabella Mitchell Logan; Brother of Lincoln Lawrence, William Malcolm "Mickey" Logan and Infant boy Logan who died in 1906 - (18) - Feb 26, 1909 - Feb 8, 1926 - Age 16 Years - The community was unspeakably shocked and grieved by a tragic shooting accident which resulted in the death of a fine young man, Alva Logan.  
**LOGAN, AMELIA FRANCIS BREEN "EMMA"** - (Mrs. David M. Logan); Mother of David, Kenneth, Amelia, Clara, Edith (Finch) and Margaret; Daughter of Michael and Julia Tobin Breen; Sister of Mary Breen Logan, Julia Breen Rolph, Maggie Breen Melton, John and Thomas Breen - July 9, 1866 - Oct 31, 1913  
**LOGAN, EMMA** - See Logan, Amelia (She was usually called Emma)  
**LOGAN, GEORGE C.** - Husband of Mary Breen; Father of Agnes, Michael, another son, name not known, Henry K. Logan and Mary "Molly" Logan (later Ross); Son of David and Agnes Mathieson Logan; Brother of David M. and William Davidson Logan, Jennie Logan (Mrs. P.H.) Campbell, Catherine Logan Newcomb, Elizabeth Logan (Mrs. Patrick) Joyce and Mrs. Alexander Stevenson - 1863 - Mar 17, 1923  
**LOGAN, INFANT** - Child of George C. and Mary Breen Logan - Died Sept 10, 1898  
**LOGAN, INFANT BOY** - Son of William Davidson and Isabella Mitchell Logan; Brother of Lincoln Lawrence, Alva George and William Malcolm "Mickey" Logan - Mar 6, 1906 - Mar 8, 1906 - Age 2 Days  
**LOGAN, LEVIN P., DR.** - Son of Jeanette Buckner Thruston Logan Rader (Mrs. Dr. William H. Rader) - Sept 30, 1869 - Nov 1, 1898  
**LOGAN, LINCOLN LAWRENCE** - Son of William Davidson and Mary Isabella Mitchell Logan; Brother of Alva George and William Malcolm "Mickey" Logan and Infant boy Logan who died in 1906 - Feb 12, 1907 - Apr 9, 1930  
**LOGAN, MARY BREEN** - (Mrs. George C. Logan); Mother of Agnes, Michael, Infant who died in 1898, Mary "Molly" Logan (later Ross) and Henry K. Logan; Daughter of Michael and Julia Tobin Breen; Sister of Amelia "Emma" Breen Logan, Julia Breen Rolph, Maggie Breen Melton, John and Thomas Breen; Granddaughter of Tom and Pasquala Bernal Tobin - Apr 8, 1867 - Apr 20, 1906  
**LOGAN, MICHAEL D.** - Infant Son of George C. and Mary Breen Logan - Aug 2, 1894 - Aug 29, 1894 - Age 27 Days  
**LOGAN, WILLIAM DAVIDSON** - Husband of Mary Isabella Mitchell; Father of Alva George,

Lawrence Lincoln and William Malcolm "Mickey" Logan and Infant boy who died in 1906; Son of David and Agnes Mathieson Logan; Brother of David M. and George C. Logan and of Jennie Logan (Mrs. P.H.) Campbell, Catherine Logan Newcomb, Elizabeth Logan (Mrs. Patrick) Joyce and Mrs. Alexander Stevenson - 1871 - Nov 19, 1940

**LONERGAN** - There were basically two Lonergan families in Silverton ... the children of Tom and Ellen Sullivan Lonergan and the children of Paul and Julia Carroll (or Carrell) Lonergan. Tom Lonergan and Paul Lonergan were brothers. The two sets of parents (Tom and Ellen, Paul and Julia) remained in Ballyhooly, County Cork, Ireland, and did not come to America; however, many of their children did come to America and to Silverton. The graves of those buried at Hillside are in the Irish section of the cemetery  
**LONERGAN, AGNES "BABY AGNES"** - Daughter of Patrick and Nora Coughlin Lonergan; Sister of Thomas Bryan "Pat" and William Maurice "Demmy" Lonergan and Ella E. Lonergan (later Schofield) - Nov 27, 1908 - Apr 23, 1912 - Age 3 Years

**LONERGAN, CATHERINE McCARTHY (Auntie Kate)** - (Mrs. John Lonergan, Sr.); Mother of John Francis Lonergan; Daughter of Timothy and Mary Ward McCarthy; Sister of Mary McCarthy (Mrs. Maurice T.) Lonergan - May 7, 1851 - May 27, 1911

**LONERGAN, CHILD** - Child of Maurice P. "Red Mountain Maurice" and Annie Muldoon Lonergan - The obituary of Maurice P. Lonergan stated he was buried beside his child and beside his sister, Kate Lonergan Beecher

**LONERGAN, ELIZA** - Daughter of Thomas and Ellen Sullivan Lonergan; Sister of Hannah Lonergan Geany, Nora Lonergan Coughlin, John, Michael, Patrick and Maurice T. "Uncle Daddy" Lonergan - May 7, 1851 - Oct 20, 1922

**LONERGAN, ELIZABETH BRIDGET "LIZZIE" MONAHAN** - (Mrs. William Paul Lonergan); Mother of Paul, Julia Rose and Kathleen Bridget Lonergan; Daughter of James and Catherine Lynch Monahan - Aug 8, 1870 - Jan 20, 1935

**LONERGAN, JOHN F., JR. (JOHNNY)** - Son of John and Catherine McCarthy Lonergan; Grandson of Tom and Ellen Sullivan Lonergan - May 7, 1882 - Aug 4, 1904 - Age 22 Years

**LONERGAN, JOHN** - Husband of Catherine "Auntie Kate" McCarthy; Father of John Francis Lonergan; Son of Tom and Ellen ("Nellie") Sullivan Lonergan; Brother of Maurice T. "Uncle Daddy", Michael, Patrick and Eliza Lonergan and of Hannah Lonergan Geany and Nora Lonergan Coughlin - Apr 29, 1845 - May 17, 1917

**LONERGAN, JULIA AGNES** - See Lonergan, Baby Agnes

**LONERGAN, JULIA ROSE** - Daughter of William Paul and Elizabeth Bridget "Lizzie" Monahan Lonergan; Sister of Paul Lonergan and Kathleen Bridget Lonergan later Doshier; Granddaughter of Paul and Julia Carroll Lonergan - Jan 17, 1906 - Aug 9, 1942

**LONERGAN, MARY ANN MCCARTHY** - (Mrs. Maurice T. "Uncle Daddy" Lonergan); Mother of William "Black Willie" Lonergan; Daughter of Timothy and Mary Ward McCarthy; Sister of Catherine McCarthy (Mrs. John Lonergan) - May 1865 - Sept 10, 1922

**LONERGAN, MAURICE P. "RED MOUNTAIN MAURICE"** - Husband of Annie Muldoon; Son of Paul and Julia Carroll Lonergan; Brother of Kate Lonergan Beecher, Agnes Bridget Lonergan Fox, William Paul Lonergan ("Will the Marshal"), Mrs. Connolly and Mrs. Maloney - 1859 - Feb 12, 1914

**LONERGAN, MAURICE T. "UNCLE DADDY" or "DUBLIN ROOSTER"** - Husband of Mary Ann McCarthy; Father of William "Black Willie" Lonergan; Son of Tom and Ellen Sullivan Lonergan; Brother of John, Michael, Patrick and Eliza Lonergan and Hannah Lonergan Geany and Nora Lonergan Coughlin - Apr 21, 1850 - May 3, 1905 - There were two Maurice Lonergans - (cousins) in the Silverton area at the same time. This one, Maurice T., was called "Uncle Daddy" by family members, and was called "The Irish Rooster" or "The Dublin Rooster" by most of the miners. A saloon operator, he was small but feisty, and had a long red beard reaching the floor which he folded under his vest.

**LONERGAN, PATRICK "PATSY"** - Husband of Nora Coughlin; Father of Thomas Bryan "Pat", William Maurice "Demmy", Ella E. and Julia Agnes "Baby Agnes" Lonergan; Son of Tom and Ellen ("Nellie") Sullivan Lonergan; Brother of John, Michael, Maurice T. "Uncle Daddy" and Eliza

Lonergan and of Hannah Lonergan Geany and Nora Lonergan Coughlin - Mar 1867 - Mar 7, 1911  
**LONERGAN, PAUL** - Son of William Paul "Will the Marshal" and Elizabeth Bridget Monahan Lonergan; Grandson of Paul and Julia Carroll Lonergan - Mar 31, 1904 - Jan 5, 1928 - Age 23 Years  
**LONERGAN, THOMAS BRYAN "PAT"** - Son of Patrick and Nora Coughlin Lonergan; Brother of William Maurice "Demmy", Julia Agnes "Baby Agnes" Lonergan and Ella E. Lonergan Schofield; Grandson of Tom and Ellen Sullivan Lonergan - May 2, 1896 - Dec 6, 1945  
**LONERGAN, WILLIAM PAUL "WILL THE MARSHAL"** - Husband of Elizabeth Bridget "Lizzie" Monahan; Father of Paul, Julia Rose and Kathleen Bridget Lonergan; Son of Paul and Julia Carroll Lonergan; Brother of Maurice P. "Red Mountain Maurice", Kate (married Beecher) and Agnes Bridget (married Edmund Fox) Lonergan - Dec 13, 1867 - Oct 23, 1948  
**LONG, JOSEPH R.** - 1834 - Apr 4, 1899  
**LONG, THOMAS J.** - Brother of U.D. Long - Died Dec 23, 1896 - This prospector for earthly riches was now seeking eternal gems.  
**LONG, WILLIAM "BILLY"** - Suicide by Cutting his Throat - Son of James and Jean Clarke Long - Mar 9, 1862 - June 21, 1908  
**LOOFBURROW, CHARLES H.** - Died May 7, 1903 - Age 35 Years  
**LOPEZ, BRAULIO** - Husband of Bernadanda; Father of Joe Lopez, Mary Lopez Romero and Carmine Lopez Boughan; Son of Narista and Julianita Vallejos Gallegos Lopez - Mar 26, 1882 - Feb 4, 1948  
**LOPEZ, JOSE D.** - Son of Florentino and Ameliana Lopez - July 1, 1920 - Oct 20, 1920 - Age 3 Months, 19 Days  
**LOPEZ, RAY** - Flu - Son of Anderas Lopez - Mar 21, 1898 - Oct 29, 1918  
**LOPEZ, WILLIE, JR.** - Son of Willie, Sr. and Medina Lopez - April 16, 1929 - Willie, born prematurely, lived but 20 minutes  
**LORANGE, LOUIS D.A.** - Son of Louis S. and Sophia Olson Lorange - Oct 6, 1898 - Oct 17, 1905  
**LORENZ** - See Lorange  
**LORENZANI, GERENANA or GERMANO** - Cave-in - Died Apr 15, 1909 - Age 27 Years - While working at the Sunnyside Mine Terry Tunnel, he was caught and crushed by a cave-in
