MACCONNI, PIETRO “PETE” - Flu – Died Nov 5, 1918 - Age 39 Years - Pete died of the deadly flu at the Iowa Tiger Mine,

MACHETTO, LOUIS - This name appeared in the list of flu dead published November 1, 1918, but was not in later corrected lists and no other references were found.

MACHMER - Also spelled Mackmer

MACHMER, H.K. "BUFFALO" - Brother of I.K. Machmer - Died June 12, 1897 - Age 47 Years - "Buffalo" passed in his checks on an early Saturday evening.

MAFFEI, CONSTANTINO AUGUST "GUS" - Husband of Letizia Caradini Maffei; Father of Julia Ann Maffei Murray; Grandfather of Lynn Murray; Son of Pasquali and Marie Biggi Maffei - Feb 22, 1875 - Mar 19, 1939

MAFFEI, INFANT BOY - Son of Constantino August "Gus" and Letizia Caradini Maffei; Brother of Julia Ann Maffei (Maffey) - Dec 23, 1912 - Dec 29, 1912

MAFFEI, JULIA ANN (formerly Mrs. Claude Murray); Mother of Lynn Murray; Grandmother of Doug Murray; Daughter of Constantino August "Gus" and Letizia Caradini Maffei; Sister of Infant Boy Died 1912 - July 19, 1902 - July 1, 1987

MAFFEI, LETIZIA CARADINI - (Mrs. Constantino August "Gus" Maffei); Mother of Julia Ann Maffey (formerly Murray) and Infant Boy Murray; Grandmother of Lynn Murray; Great-grandmother of Douglas Stephen Murray - Aug 21, 1882 - Apr 28, 1956

MAGUIRE, MARY FRANCES LOFTUS - (Mrs. Michael Joseph Maguire #3); Mother of Thomas Francis, Loretta May, William Edward and Loftus James Maguire; Daughter of Thomas L. and Mary Higgins Loftus; Sister of Clara Bridget Loftus Hastings Mullooly, Thomas L. Loftus, Jr., and Patrick Loftus - Feb 7, 1864 - Mar 4, 1944

MAGUIRE, THOMAS - Son of Michael Joseph and Julia Cain Maguire - July 23, 1887 - Apr 28, 1888 - Age 9 Months 5 Days

MAGUIRE, THOMAS FRANCIS - Husband of Mary Frances Stringer; Son of Michael Joseph and Mary

Loftus Maguire; Brother of Loretta May, William Edward and Loftus James Maguire - May 15, 1892 - Aug 12, 1978

MAGUIRE, WILLIAM EDWARD, SR. "BILLY" - Husband of Marguerite "Margery" Seay, Margaret Brayden, Callie Waggoner and Mrs. Mildred Garrison; Father of William Edward Maguire, Jr., and Madeline May "Jackie" Maguire; Son of Michael Joseph and Mary Frances Loftus Maguire; Brother of Thomas Francis, Loretta May and Loftus James Maguire - June 23, 1896 - Mar 19, 1974

MALLET, SAMUEL - Mine Explosion - Died Oct 20, 1900 - Age 43 Years - Sam, who had lived in the district about fifteen years, was horribly killed at the Sunnyside Mine

MANICK, MARGARET DEBATTISTE CASAGRANDA "MAGGIE" - (Mrs. Sam Manick, formerly Mrs. Pete Casagranda); Mother of Peter Casagranda; Daughter of Domenico and Mary Postagni Debattiste; Sister of Theresa Debattiste Orella - Dec 27, 1887 - Jan 14, 1952

MANICK, SAMUEL J. - Husband of Margaret "Maggie" Debattiste Casagranda - June 26, 1892 - Dec 1, 1947

MAPLE, JOSEPH ANDREW - Husband of Miriam Eliza Foster King; Son of Joseph W. Maple - Mar 15, 1864 or 1865 - Dec 23, 1928

MAPLE, MIRIAM ELIZA FOSTER KING - (Mrs. Joseph Andrew Maple; formerly Mrs. John F. King, Sr.); Mother of Mary Edith King Ferguson McElhaney (later Matte) and John H. King, Jr.; Daughter of Perry and Judy Likes Foster; Sister of Bessie Foster Case Farmer - Sept 8, 1866 - June 27, 1930

MARAFETTI, JAMES - Mine Accident - Son of Louis and Angelina P. Marafetti - 1887 - Nov 23, 1916

MARCHAND, MARIE ARTHEMISE BEAUDRY - (Mrs. Joseph Edward Marchand #1); Mother of Marie Arthemise, Nora, Pearl and Edward Marchand - May 16, 1850 - Apr 6, 1883

MARCHES, HERMAN JOE - Husband of Nell Grace Cato and Louise Taylor; Father of Sharon Marches Schilthius Daniel; Son of Joe Marches and Olivia Franch Marches (later Ghensi and Pilati) - Feb 9, 1909 - July 7, 1987

MARCHES, JOE - Flu - Husband of Olivia Franch (later Ghensi, Pilati); Father of Herman Joe Marches and Lena Marches Carrigan - 1881 - Oct 26, 1918

MARCHES, NELL GRACE CATO "NELLIE" - (Mrs. Herman Joe Marches); Mother of Sharon Marches Schilthius (later Daniel); Daughter of Hugh Clem and Jessie Emily Patterson Cato (later Stavely); Sister of Vernon, Edna, Hazel, Jessie and Marguerite Cato; Half-Sister of Bob and Betty Stavely; Granddaughter of Julius Brice and Julia Garren Patterson - Oct 1, 1906 - Nov 18, 1976

MARKT, ADOLPH E. - Son of William and Hortense Markt; Brother of Louis Markt; Uncle of Hortense McGovern - Apr 13, 1873 - Dec 3, 1905

MARLER, JAMES LEROY - Son of Gene and Cecilia Arietta Marler - May 5, 1941 - May 8, 1941 - Age 3 Days

MARLO, MICHAEL - (Marlo was sometimes spelled Mario or Merlo) - Mine Explosion - Died Aug 30, 1907 - Age 40 Years

MARMOYLE, JAMES - Also spelled Mormoyle, Narmoyle - Died July 13, 1908 - Age 55 Years

MARR, FRED T. - Suicide - Poison - Husband of E.G. Marr; Son of John Marr - Died July 4, 1921 - Age 41 Years - Fred, a miner, committed suicide by the strychnine route at his home, 1357 Reese Street

MARSH, CANFIELD JAMES - Suicide - Poison - Husband of Nancy Maria Taylor; Father of Julia Emma Marsh Earl, Nora Barton Marsh Todd, Theodore Barton Marsh, Frank Herbert Marsh, Alma Sophronia Marsh Vicary and Sarah Maria Marsh; Grandfather of Frank Earl and Nannie Todd (buried at Hillside) - Dec 30, 1820 - July 25, 1883

MARSH, GRACE - Suicide - Poison by Morphine - Died June 26, 1885 - An overdose of morphine ended the trials and tribulations of Grace Marsh, one of Blair Street's soiled doves

MARSHALL, CHARLES ALMOND "AL" - Flu - Husband of Florence Adelia Molander; Son of Ira and Julia Marshall - June 5, 1866 - Oct 24, 1918

MARSHALL, FLORENCE ADELIA MOLANDER - Mrs. Charles Almond "Al" Marshall; Daughter of Eunice Augusta Jane Emmons Molander; Sister of Bertha O. Molander Shrout and Martha Jane Molander Fassbinder; Granddaughter of William and Martha J. Beckett Emmons - Nov 20, 1876 - Mar 8, 1943

MARSHALL, JAMES S. - Snowslide - Died Feb 12, 1878 - James was killed in a snowslide on Stuart Mountain in Poughkeepsie Gulch, above Animas Forks

MARTAIN - See Martin

MARTELLANO, ANTONIO DOMINICK - Son of Martino and Domenica Scolarone Martellano; Uncle of Dominick Motto - Jan 17, 1867 - Feb 10, 1916

MARTELLANO, JAMES (GIACOMO) - Uncle of Pete Motto and Jim Martellano - Died Dec 9, 1916

MARTELLANO, MARY - See Mary Fiocone

MARTIN, BERT H. - Fractured Skull in Mine Accident - Died Dec 18, 1903 - Age 30 Years - In the late afternoon while keying tappets on the stamps at the Sunnyside Mill at Eureka, Bert fell backward off the platform a distance of ten feet, struck the back of his head against a piece of machinery and fractured his skull

MARTIN, BYRD EDWARD - Suicide - Son of Edward Martin - Nov 16, 1885 - Dec 28, 1931

MARTIN, INFANT GIRL - Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Martin - May 30, 1896 - Jan 7, 1897 - Age 7 Months

MARTIN, JOHN - See Gobel, John Martin - Died Dec 31, 1905 or January 1, 1906 - Accounts differed - John was known in the Silverton area as both John Martin and John Gobel, and one newspaper referred to him as John Gable. His name appeared as John Gobel on the Gold King Mine payroll book.

MARTIN, JOHN - Died Sept 21, 1919 - Age 55 Years

MARTIN, LOUIS - Mine Explosion - Died Aug 7, 1894

MARTINEZ, ANDREW "ANDY" - Died Apr 10, 1924 - Age 48 Years

MARTINEZ, DIEGO - Flu - Died Oct 26, 1918 - Diego, age unknown, died in the flu epidemic

MARTINEZ, FREDERICK PETE "FREDDIE" - Son of Juan and Christina Sena Martinez - Dec 20, 1913 - Aug 20, 1992

MARTINEZ, GEORGE - Husband of Grace Agnes Voorhies Domingues; Son of Andy Martinez (died 1919) and Sylvia Lucero Martinez - June 17, 1887 - Dec 7, 1944

MARTINEZ, GRACE AGNES VOORHIES DOMINGUES - (Mrs. George Martinez, formerly Mrs. Jose Francisco Domingues) - Mother of Viola Bernice and Christana Eleanor Domingues (or Dominguez); Raised Sylvia Martinez (Gardner, Craig, Downing) - Dec 24, 1879 - Feb 5, 1967

MARTINEZ, JUAN VANTISTA, JR - Son of Juan Vantista Martinez, Sr. and Mary Casias Martinez - June 1, 1930 - June 10, 1930 - Age 9 Days

MARTUNELLANO, DOMINICK - See Martellano, Dominick

MASCARENAS, ABEL DONALD - Son of Celso L. Mascarenas and Elvira Martinez Mascarenas (or Masacerras) - Apr 13, 1928 - Apr 14, 1928 - Age 1 Day

MASON, CHRIS - Died Aug 27, 1895 - Chris, a Silverton old timer, died of pneumonia

MASON, ELIZABETH - 1873 - 1899

MASON, VIRGIL FRANCIS, SR., SHERIFF - Father of Christi Mason (Lancaster), Sheryl Mason (Cash), Virgil Francis Mason, Jr., and Michael Berry Mason; Son of Dominic and Grace Spagnola Mason; Brother of Frances Mason Heffern and Marie Mason Bunker - Mar 6, 1920 - Dec 2, 1978

MASON, WILLIAM - Died Dec 14, 1906 - Age 51 Years - William, a native of Wales, died of tuberculosis

MASTERS, HARRY J. - Alcoholism - Died Oct 1, 1909 - Age 36 Years

MASTERSON, ZACK T. - Morphine - Died Apr 5, 1895 - Age 50 Years

MATAVI - See Mattivi

MATEER - See Matteer

MATRESS, JOHN - Also Spelled Matross - Flu - Son of Frank Matress - July 1, 1896 - Oct 29, 1918

MATROSS - See Matress

MATSON, AUGUST - Mine Cave-in - Died June 13, 1903

MATSON, HERMAN - Son of Herman Stransholm - May 5, 1886 - Mar 7, 1923

MATSON, HERMAN - Son of Matt and Johanna Hallender Hansen; Brother of Emil A., Matt and Vic Matson - Feb 13, 1894 - Aug 3, 1943

MATTEER, SAMUEL BARBOUR - - Husband of Mary Finn; Son of Martin Matteer - Feb 20, 1859 - Mar 15, 1932

MATTIES, BAPTISTE - Mine Cave-in - Nephew of Battist and Jack Matties - Oct 15, 1877 - Jan 15, 1901 - Age 23 Years

MATTIES (MATTIVI), BATTIST - Husband of Ottilia Roccabruna; Father of Lucia Maria (Crippled Mary), Lina, Lena Carole, John Battist, Joseph and William George "Billy" Matties; Son of B. Matties; Brother of Jack Matties; Uncle of Baptiste Matties; Cousin of Carlo Zancanella - Jan 18, 1867 - Apr 2, 1924

MATTIES, GIACOMO (JACK) "CACO" - Cousin of Mary (Lucia Maria "Crippled Mary") Matties - 1891 - Dec 18, 1956

MATTIES, LINA - Daughter of Battist and Ottilia Roccabruna Matties; Sister of Lena Carole, John Battist, Joseph and William George Matties; Half-sister of Lucia Maria "Crippled Mary" Matties - Nov 12, 1906 - Feb 4, 1907

MATTIES, WILLIAM GEORGE "BILLY" - Son of Battist and Ottilia Roccabruna Matties; Brother of Lina, Lena Carole, John and Joe Matties; Half-brother of Lucia Maria "Crippled Mary" Matties - Apr 28, 1922 - July 22, 1943

MATTIVI - Also spelled Mattevi and Matties, and other variations - Some members of the Mattivi family changed the spelling of the name to "Matties" after settling in America.

MATTIVI, A. - Flu - Died Oct 26, 1918

MATTIVI, ANGELO - Flu - Son of John and Catterina Fontana Mattivi; Brother of Battista, Bonaventura, Domenico, Giovanni, Giuseppe and Luigi, Angela, Catherine and Marie Mattivi - Mar 17, 1888 - Oct 27, 1918

MATTIVI, BARTOLLO - Mine Cave-in - Died Jan 27, 1896 - Age 44 Years - Bartollo met death in a fearful manner at the North Star Mine on Sultan Mountain

MATTIVI, BATTISTA - Electrocutted - Son of Giovanni and Catterina Fontana Mattivi; Brother of Angelo, Bonaventura, Domenico, Giovanni, Giuseppe, Luigi, Angela, Catherine and Marie Mattivi - Apr 27, 1886 - Oct 10, 1914

MATTIVI, BEN - Son of Niccolo Mattivi; Brother of Joe Mattivi - 1876 - Jan 30, 1906

MATTIVI, BONAVENTURA (BEN) - Son of Giovanni and Catterina Fontana Mattivi; Brother of Angelo, Battista, Domenico, Giovanni, Giuseppe, Luigi, Angela, Catherine and Marie Mattivi - 1878 - Apr 26, 1918

MATTIVI, DOMENICO - Son of Giovanni and Catterina Fontana Mattivi; Brother of Angelo, Battista, Bonaventura (Ben), Giovanni (John, Giuseppe (Joe), Luigi, Angela, Catherine and Marie Mattivi - 1897 - June 15, 1925

MATTIVI, EVARISTO - (Also spelled Mattevi; Same person as A. Mattivi?) - Flu - Oct 1884 - Oct 1918

MATTIVI, FRANK - Son of Francisco Mattivi; Brother of Mrs. Annie Mattivi Luchi (Mrs. Jim Luchi) and Mrs. Dom Gracetti; Uncle of Mrs. Mary Pergamo; Cousin of Mrs. Angelo Dallabetta - Sept 9, 1895 - Sept 16, 1958

MATTIVI, GIOVANNI (JOHN) - Husband of Luigia Defant; Father of Adelina Mattivi Popovich Holmgren, Rosa Kate Mattivi Dorigatti and Infant Girl; Son of Giovanni and Catterina Fontana Mattivi; Brother of Angelo, Battista, Bonaventura, Domenico, Giuseppe, Luigi, Angela, Catherine and Marie Mattivi - July 16, 1882 - Jan 1, 1919

MATTIVI, GUIDO - 1881 - Oct 7, 1934

MAXWELL, GERTRUDE MAUDE PEARCE PAYNE - (Mrs. Nathaniel Chester Maxwell #2, formerly Mrs. Art Payne); Mother of William Arthur, Frances Louise and Gertrude Irene Payne; Daughter of William John and Elizabeth Frances Rodda Pearce; Sister of William H., Alfred L. and Arthur James Pearce and Frances Ethel Pearce Beckwith - Aug 5, 1884 - May 29, 1974

MAXWELL, LILLIAN THARP - (Mrs. Nathaniel Chester Maxwell #1) - Mother of Wilbur Tharp Maxwell and Sara Frances Maxwell Eson Baily; Daughter of James Henry and Mary Frances Jeter Tharp; Granddaughter of W.G. and Elizabeth M. Berry Jeter - July 9, 1873 - Mar 12, 1952

MAXWELL, NATHANIEL CHESTER "NATE" - Husband of Lillian Tharp and Gertrude Maude Pearce Payne; Father of Wilbur Tharp Maxwell and Sara Frances Maxwell Eson Baily; Son of Albert Leander and Harriet Brown Maxwell - July 31, 1873 - Sept 10, 1961

MAXWELL, WILBUR THARP - Suffocated in Mine Cave-in - Son of Nathaniel Chester and Lillian Tharp Maxwell; Brother of Sara Frances Maxwell Eson Baily - Sept 4, 1898 - Sept 7, 1945

MAYERS, EMMANUEL - Suicide - Husband of Gottlieben Louisa Hinderer; Father of Lillie Mayers Tiffany, Cornelia Frederica "Nellie Rica" Mayers Mayers, Bertha Mayers Miller Nicholson; Alice Mayers Hicks; and a daughter, unknown first name Mayers Batz - Nov 13, 1828 - July 1, 1886

MAYGER, INFANT - Child of George and Olive Barresca Mayger - Died May 21, 1906 - This premature child was stillborn, and the mother died of peritonitis three days later

MAYNARD, RONALD KEN "BUD" - Son of Donald Edmond and Blendena Maynard; Brother of one, name not known - Sept. 27, 1928 - Apr. 25, 2009

MAYNARD, S.A., MRS. - Died Nov 24, 1901

MAYNES, LOUISE ANESI - 5-13-1910 - 11-8-2005

MAYNES, SAMUEL CLARENCE - 6-27-1908 - 8-16-1980

McANDREWS, ANDREW "ANDY" - Brother of Dave McAndrews - 1846 - Mar 17, 1888

McCAFFERTY, JAMES - Civil War Veteran - Died Mar 13, 1891

McCAFFREY, INFANT - Child of Mr. and Mrs. Owen McCaffrey - Died September 4, 1897

McCARRON, JACK "SLOPPY JACK" - Veteran- Son of David McCarron - May 20, 1858 - July 17, 1943

McCARTHY, CALLAHAN - Exposure and Freezing on Sultan Mountain - Brother of Eugene McCarthy - 1854 - Dec 23, 1884

McCARTHY, CHARLES - Son of Daniel McCarthy - Died Jan 15, 1907 - Age 24 Years

McCARTHY, CORA H. - Daughter of Eugene and Hannah Relahan McCarthy; Sister of Eugene J. McCarthy - July 2, 1881 - July 27, 1888 - Age 7 Years

McCARTHY, EDWARD (also known as Howard, Joseph) - Died Oct 31, 1903 - Age 45 Years

McCARTHY, EUGENE - Husband of Hannah Relahan; Father of Cora H. and Eugene J. McCarthy; Brother of Cal McCarthy - 1846 - Dec 26, 1890

McCARTNEY, ROBERT J. "BOB" or "MAC" - Husband of Matilda "Tillie" Garwin - Aug 12, 1857 - Feb 9, 1904

McCLAIN, JAMES ESLEY "JERRY" - Son of John McClain; Brother of Mrs. Lulu McClain Moore and Mrs. Jesse Harnish - Jan 15, 1895 - Oct 23, 1937

McCLINTOCK, ROLLY E. - Suicide - Gunshot - Son of R.C. and Mildred Caroline Youtsey McClintock; Brother of A.L. McClintock - Died July 23, 1907 - Age 39 Years
