PACKALEN (or PACKLEN), OSCAR - Flu - Son of Carl Packalen; Brother of Arthur Packalen - Sept 12, 1876 - Oct 19, 1918

PACKARD, S. (Also referred to as Salmon, Sahrion and Solomon Packard or Rickard) - Died Dec 10, 1905

PACKLEN - See Packalen

PACOTTI, ANNA LOUISE LEHMAN - (Mrs. John Baptisti Pacotti); Mother of Anna Wilda Pacotti Tucker; Daughter of Joseph and Emma Julius Lehman; Grandmother of James Tucker; Sister of Margaret Nallon Murphy and Rose Nallon Rice - Feb 2, 1898 - Feb 18, 1967

PADDISON, INFANT GIRL - Daughter of L.F. and Anna Boyd Paddison - Died May 12, 1920 - Age 7-1/2 Hours

PADILLA, INFANT BOY - Son of Angelo and Teresa Pagneri Padilla (Sometimes spelled Pardillo) - Died Dec 17, 1914

PADILLA, INFANT BOY - Son of Angelo and Teresa Pagneri Padilla - Died Sept 25, 1916 - After a difficult breech birth, this child was stillborn

PADILLA, STEVE - Son of Pete and Rose Mascarenas Padilla - Mar 13, 1924 - Apr 13, 1924 - Age 1 Month

PADLOGAR, FRANK - 1883 - Oct 25, 1940 – Native of Yugoslavia

PAGLERIO, ANTONIO - Son of Giuseppe and Caterina Papas Giachetto Paglerio; Brother of Dominic Paglerio; Uncle of Paul Troglia - 1874 - Jan 12, 1913

PALMER, PAUL CLARK - Flu - Son of William J. and Elizabeth Clark Palmer - Jan 8, 1899 - Oct 27, 1918 - Age 19 Years

PALORE OR PALNAEO, ANTONIO "TONY" - Died Oct 14, 1904 - Age 33 Years

PANTALEONE, ADELINA - Died 1906 - Pneumonia - Daughter of Giacomo (James) and Emelia Serena Molinario Pantaleone (later Michielutti); Twin sister of Andraina Maria Pantaleone - July 20, 1905 - July 12, 1906

PANTALEONE, ANDRANIA MARIA -Died 1906 - Gastroenteritis and Bronchitis - Daughter of Giacomo (James) and Emelia Serena Molinario Pantaleone (later Michielutti); Twin Sister of Adelina Pantaleone- July 20, 1905 - July 29, 1906 - Age 1 Year

PAPPAS, AUGUSTUS "GUST" - Oct 1, 1883 - May 27, 1934

PARDEY, FRANK - 1863 – 1937

PARDILLO - See Padilla

PARKER, VERNON O. - Husband of Eloise; Step-father of Allen Parker; Son of James Madison and Anna Bills Parker; Brother of Julian E. Parker, Calude Madison Parker, Mary "Mamie" Docia Parker Squires, Lillian Parker Jarrett, Anna Bills Parker, Esther Ruth Parker Dan Jennie M. Parker, and Vera I. Parker Volk; Grandson of Green and Catherine "Docia" Burns Parker - Ashes scattered at Animas Forks - 1899 - July 4, 1978

PARMALEE - See Parmlee

PARMLEE, JOSEPH "LITTLE JOE" (Also spelled Parmalee) – Froze to Death - Died Dec 9, 1893 (approximately)

PASCOE, FRANK - Died Jan 9, 1910 - Age 63 Years - On a Sunday night the grim reaper once more wielded his scythe of time, and called to more blissful realms above the soul of genial old Frank Pascoe

PASCOE, WILLIAM HENRY - Feb 7, 1854 - Mar 5, 1908

PASCOTINI, JONBATISTO - (Also spelled Boscotana, Pasinatina, Pascutini) - Terry Tunnel Snowslide with Four Others - Son of Giovanni and Maria Agnola Pascotini - Feb 20, 1876 - Jan 22, 1906 - Age 29 Years -The funeral for the five Italians, under the auspices of the Miners Union, was never forgotten by anyone who witnessed it.

PASO, MARY - Daughter of Arthur Carl and Isabelle Cleotilde Gallegos Paso - Died Sept 12, 1947

PASSERINI, GIULIO (JULIUS) - Flu - Husband of Pierina Franchini; Father of Fred "Nando" Passerini and Delphina Passerini - 1887 - Oct 29, 1918 - Age 29 Years - Louie Dalla once recalled that he was also

very sick with flu at the time Giulio died. Giulio brought ten year old Louie a drink of water, then laid down and died.

PATRIQUIN, GEORGE HENRY – Typhoid Pneumonia - Husband of Mabel Card; Son of James and Matilda Pick Patriquin - Nov 4, 1865 or 1866 - Sept 4, 1910

PATTERSON, BRICE - Scarlet Fever - Son of Alva Oliver and Anna Elizabeth Martin Patterson (later Dunagan); Grandson of Julius Brice and Julia Caroline Garren Patterson; Brother of Julia Francis, Robert and Harry "Bud" Patterson - Feb 17, 1906 - May 5, 1908 - Age 2 Years

PATTERSON, CLARENCE HOWARD "TUD" - Husband of Agnes R. Croke and Mrs. Minnie Alenia McClung; Son of William J. and Mrs. Patterson - Nov 27, 1883 - Aug 26, 1941

PATTERSON, HARRY T. "HOD" – Appendicitis and Peritonitis - Husband of Hattie Humphries; Son of J. Brice and Julia Caroline Garren Patterson; Brother of Fred and Alva Patterson and Jessie Emily Patterson Cato Stavely - Oct 24, 1883 - June 29, 1912

PATTERSON, JULIUS BRICE - Husband of Julia Caroline Garren; Son of Sam and Emily Moore Patterson; Father of Julius Frederick "Fred", Harry T. "Hod" and Alva Oliver Patterson, and Jessie Emily Patterson Cato Stavely - Dec 29, 1853 - Dec 10, 1945 - Age 91 Years

PATTERSON, JULIA CAROLINE GARREN - (Mrs. J. Brice Patterson); Mother of Julius Frederick "Fred", Harry T. "Hod" and Alva Oliver Patterson, and Jessie Patterson Cato Stavely; Daughter of John and Annie Garren - Oct 24, 1863 - Oct 9, 1942

PATTERSON, JULIUS FREDERICK "FRED" - Husband of Susie Armstrong and Myrtle Sarah (Serra?) Graham; Son of Julius Brice and Julia Caroline Garren Patterson; Brother of Harry "Hod" and Alva Patterson and Jessie Patterson Cato Stavely - Mar 5, 1882 - Feb 22, 1945

PATTERSON, ROBERT - Son of Alva and Anna Martin Patterson - Apr 9, 1910 - Aug 24, 1910 - Age 4-1/2 Months

PATTON, TRICIA "TRISH" WARD – Wife of Gene Patton, Daughter of Robert Roy "Bob" Ward and Ruth Lemm Ward; Sister of Nancy Ward – 1967 – Feb. 26, 2009

PATZER, SCOTT DEAN - Jan 23, 1966 - Aug 21, 1994 - Scott's ashes were scattered near the Highland Mary Lake in August 1994

PAULAIS, THEOPHILE, MRS. - Died Jan 9, 1891 (approximately)

PAUSA, RICARDO - Husband of Anita Salazar (14) – Died August 2001 in Albuquerque, New Mexico

Ricardo, born in Argentina, died in Albuquerque, New Mexico; his cremated remains were to be buried at Hillside in early September 2001, next to Ila Mary Salazar, his sister-in-law. Ricardo's wife, the former Anita Salazar, was the daughter of Jose Doroteo "Joe D." Salazar and the former Maria Delubina Candelaria. Anita's brothers and sisters were Laura Salazar Stultz, Ila Mary Salazar, Ole Salazar, Jerry Salazar, George Florentino Salazar, Horace Salazar, Joe Isador Salazar, Joe D. Salazar Jr., and two boys, both named Walter, who died in infancy.

PAVEGLIO, ALFRED - Son of Santo Paveglio - Died Apr 13, 1920 - Alfred died at the Sunnyside Mine boarding house after being ill with pneumonia

PAVEGLIO, DOMINICK - Terry Tunnel Snowslide with Four Others - Son of Dominick Paveglio, Sr. June 17, 1865 - Jan 22, 1906 - Age 40 Years - On a Monday morning at the new Terry Tunnel of the Sunnyside Mine, about two miles west of Eureka on Hanson Peak, six miners were working at the mouth of the tunnel when a snowslide suddenly came down the mountain, covered the men and carried five of them to their deaths

PAVEGLIO, MATTIA - Son of John and Santa Paveglio; Cousin of Rodolfo Paveglio - Feb 27, 1874 - Feb 23, 1911

PAVEGLIO, PIETRO – Pneumonia - Son of Oswald and Santina Dellabona Paveglio - 1873 - Feb 24, 1906

PAVEGLIO, RODOLFO - Snowslide - Son of Denny and Carolina Paveglio; Cousin of Mattia Paveglio - Died Mar 17, 1906 - Age 34 Years - Rodolfo was killed in one of the many snowslides of St. Patrick's Day in 1906

PAVEGLIO, TONY - Son of Pietro and Madelina Paveglio - Aug 4, 1856 - July 3, 1905 - Tony was found dead in his bunk at the Silver Lake boarding house.

PAVELIGO - See Paveglio

PAXTON, DILLON – Son of Keri Metzler and David Paxton; Brother of Tanner Paxton, Amber Kelso and Adam Walker; Grandson of Gib and Joylea Gibson – Dec 13, 1995 – Aug 31, 2012 – Dillon chose to be a donor through Donor Alliance

PAXTON, JOHN - Snowslide - Buried near Animas Forks -Died Dec 9, 1875 - John, who worked with the Mineral Creek sawmill crew, was killed at about 8:30 in the morning by a monstrous snowslide on Wood Mountain near Animas Forks.

PAYNE, ART - Husband of Gertrude Maude Pearce (later Maxwell); Father of William Arthur Payne, Frances Louise Payne Thompson and Gertrude Irene Payne Blatnick; Son of John and ? Marks Payne - Dec 23, 1878 - Sept 8, 1922

PAYNE, EDWIN - Son of John Payne - Oct 1, 1865 - Mar 24, 1921

PAYNE, FRANCES or L.F. - See Thompson, Frances Payne

PAYNE, WILLIAM ARTHUR "ART" - Suicide by Carbon Monoxide - Former Husband of Ruth Faye Miller; Father of Richard Arthur and Miller Robert Payne; Son of Art and Maude Pearce Payne; Brother of Frances Louise Payne Thompson and Gertrude Irene Payne Blatnick - Jan 21, 1906 - Feb 21, 1945

PEARCE, ANNA RICHARDS GOLDSWORTHY - Swallowed Poisonous Substance - (Mrs. John T. Pearce, formerly Mrs. T.B. Goldsworthy); Mother of Ernest and Thomas Henry Goldsworthy; Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. John A. Richards - 1864 - Mar 9, 1894 - On Wednesday, the 7th, it was learned that Anna Pearce was seriously ill. It was thought she had swallowed a poisonous substance. Her husband died four days after Anna's death

PEARCE, ELIZABETH FRANCES RODDA - (Mrs. William John Pearce); Mother of Arthur James, Alfred L. and William H. Pearce, Frances Ethel Pearce Beckwith, Gertrude Maude Pearce Payne Maxwell and two infant daughters; Daughter of James and M.J. Williams Rodda - Jan 22, 1864 - Nov 26, 1921 - Born in Camborne, Cornwall

PEARCE, INFANT GIRL - Daughter of William John and Elizabeth Rodda Pearce - Died September 2, 1896

PEARCE, INFANT GIRL - Daughter of William John and Elizabeth Rodda Pearce - Died July 25, 1898

PEARCE, JOHN T. "JACK" - Husband of Anna Goldsworthy; Step-father of Ernest and Thomas Henry Goldsworthy; Brother of Richard Pearce - Died Mar 13, 1894 - Age 34 Years

PEARCE, RICHARD "DICK" - Brother of John T. "Jack" Pearce - 1854 - Dec 10, 1909

PEARCE, WILLIAM - Died Apr 2, 1896 - Age 54 Years

PEARCE, WILLIAM H. - Son of William J. and Elizabeth Rodda Pearce - July 21, 1902 - Sept 19, 1902 - Age 2 Months - The prematurely born infant son of William and Elizabeth died of summer complaint on a Saturday morning - "Another little lamb has gone, his life we could not save, another little darling babe, is sheltered in the grave."

PEARCE, WILLIAM JOHN - Husband of Elizabeth Rodda; Father of Arthur James, Alfred L. and William H. Pearce, Frances Ethel Pearce Beckwith, Gertrude Maude Pearce Payne Maxwell and two infant daughters; Son of John and Elizabeth Dinsby Pearce - Apr 29, 1859 - Nov 21, 1933

PEARSON, CAROLINE GERTRUDE BAUSMAN "CARRIE" - (Mrs. Charles Pearson); Mother of Caroline Frankie Pearson Tookey; Daughter of George W. and Laura Musgrove Bausman; Sister of Alex, Frank "Ike", George "Rags" and Joe Bausman and Elizabeth "Bessie" Bausman Hughes, Adelia Bausman Cole, Laura Virginia "Jinks" Bausman Phillips Sitter, Helene Bausman Crawford, Sallie Bausman Gillespie Pawless, Mary Agnes "Mike" Bausman Santy and Marjorie "Nick" Bausman Dresback - Feb 15, 1891 - Apr 29, 1964

PECINNI, LOUIS - Died Sept 22, 1911 - Age 56 Years - Born in Italy, Louis died of miners con

PEDOT, EMILIO "CORNETTO" - Oct 11, 1878 - Mar 13, 1945 - Emilio was nicknamed "Cornetto" because of his fondness for the ladies

PEDRONI, JOHN - Son of Louis and Concessa Ricci Pedroni - April 30, 1911 - May 15, 1911 - Age 15 Days

PEDRONI, MARY - Daughter of Louis and Concessa Ricci Pedroni - Died Nov 5, 1913 – Age 6 Hours
PEDRUM - See Perdum
PEELER, MAY, MRS. - Died Aug 27, 1905 - Age 38 Years
PELICH, BEN - Flu - Son of Morro Pelich (or Pick) - 1885 - Oct 24, 1918
PENGLAIZE, RICHARD - Died July 27, 1900 - Age 45 Years
PENNICA - See Perucea
PENOFF, MARINO – Flu - Aug 12, 1884 - Oct 23, 1918
PENSE, KAREL LYNN (known as Lynn in Silverton) Wife of Ron Pense, Mother of Tamara Pense Zanoni and Scott Pense, Grandmother of Derrick Zanoni, Mason and Colton Pense, Daughter of Reginald “Tex” Bowman and Carol Filmore Bowman; Sister of Debbie Jahnke and Roxanne Miranda

PERDUM, ED (or PEDRUM, FRED) - Mine Explosion - Died Oct 12, 1895
PERHAY, JOSEPH - Son of Joseph and Angela H. Perhay - Died July 3, 1918 - Age 1-1/2 Years
PERINO, JOHN - Son of Elio M. and Filamona Piccoli Perino; Grandson of Michael and Marina Perino; Nephew of Leda Perino Sartore, Lillian Perino Jakino and Richard Perino - Died Feb 12, 1936
PERINO, MARINA PERINO - (Mrs. Michael Perino) - Mother of Elio and Richard Alfred Perino, Leda Perino Sartore and Lillian Perino Jakino - 1883 - Apr 3, 1932
PERINO, MICHAEL – Snowslide - Died Dec 31, 1891
PERINO, MICHAEL - Husband of Marina Perino; Father of Elio and Richard Alfred Perino, Leda Perino Sartore and Lillian Perino Jakino - July 10, 1868 - Oct 25, 1926
PERINO, MICHAEL M. - 1877 - June 8, 1906 - Age 29 Years - Mike, who worked as a miner, died of pneumonia
PERINO, RICHARD ALFRED “RICH” – Feb. 24, 1924 – Mar. 20, 2011
PERKINS, BRADLEY ALAN - Son of Grover and Izetta Perkins; Brother of Craig Perkins and Andrea Perkins Higdon; Uncle of Sandra and Larry Higdon - Dec 15, 1953 - Apr 29, 1995 – *Beloved Son and Brother*
PERKINS, JAMES EDWARD - 1876 - July 20, 1916
PERUCCA, LAWRENCE - Relative of Joe Chiono - 1868 - April 16, 1914 - Age 46 Years - Larry died of miners con and heart disease
PETCAVAGE, MARGARET MARIE - (Mrs. George Petcavage) - Mother of Margaret Servatka; Grandmother of Peggy Fuchs and Helen Kenney; Great-grandmother of Billy Fuchs - July 21, 1881 - Jan 8, 1973 - Age 91 Years
PETERS, C.F. "CON" - Died Nov 19, 1899 - Age 69 Years - The county gave this man a fairly respectable burial the day after his death, but if the old gent had any friends, they rendered themselves scarce at the funeral
PETERSEN, ANNA FRANCES WENZEL - Wife of Harold Christian Petersen; Mother of Janet Petersen O'Leary and William Petersen; Grandmother of Maureen, Patrick and Timothy O'Leary; Great-grandmother of Madison O'Leary - Apr 30, 1915 - Dec 26, 2004
PETERSON, AGATHA CATHERINE SALFISBERG - (Mrs. Gustav Hjalmer Peterson); Mother of Karl Joseph, Gustav Frederick, Ande Hubert and Alice Marie Peterson; Daughter of Frederick and Marie Wielang Salfisberg; Sister of Fred, Jr., Joseph Francis, Robert Samuel, Infant Boy Unnamed, Hubert W. and Francis Wielang Salfisberg, and Alice Mae Salfisberg Kornafel; Daughter of Fred and Marie (Mary) Wielang Salfisberg - June 9, 1903 - Sept 12, 1993 - Age 90 Years
PETERSON, ANN – 4-30-1915 – 12-26-2004
PETERSON, CHARLES - Son of Peter and Bertha Swanson Olquist; Cousin of Peter Holmgren - Died Oct 9, 1907 - Age 47 Years - Charles, a miner of the area, was found dead in his room at the Teller House. He suffered a hemorrhage of the stomach after alcoholism of some years
PETERSON, CHARLES HANS - Mine Accident - Died Sept 26, 1906 - Age 38 Years - While at work at the Gold King Mine exploring an abandoned stope, Charles was suddenly killed by a huge boulder which fell from the roof of the stope.
PETERSON, CHARLES OLIVER - Son of Charles Oskar and Marie Charlotta Andersdotter (Anderson) Peterson; Brother of Cecil Rowland Peterson and Cecilia Olive Peterson (Mrs. Paul) Ransom - Oct 22, 1901 - Aug 15, 1903 - Age 1 Year 10 Months
PETERSON, CHARLES OSKAR - Husband of Marie Challotta Andersdotter (Anderson); Father of Charles Oliver and Cecil Rowland Peterson and Cecilia Olive Peterson Ransom; Grandfather of Charles Edward Peterson - Sept 15, 1865 - May 4, 1937

PETERSON, EMMA SOFIA CARLSON OLSON - (Mrs. Carl O. Peterson, formerly Mrs. Charles Olson); Mother of William Albin Olson; Daughter of Charles Wedin and Hulda Mickelson; Sister of Oscar Carlson, Hedvig Johnson, Freda Carlson, and Albin Carlson; Cousin of Gus Olson; Aunt (by marriage) of Carl A. PHILLIPS, DAISY MAY SEAY - (Mrs. Lloyd Otto Phillips) - Mother of Betty Lou Phillips; Daughter of Cecil and Della Sherwood Seay; Sister of Bill, John and LaRue Seay and Margie Seay Maguire O'Brien - June 22, 1891 - April 28, 1956

PHILLIPS, ED "TEX" - Died Dec 13, 1898 - Tex was found unconscious and dying in front of Ludwig Vota's dance hall at 2:00 a.m. on a freezing Tuesday morning

PHILLIPS, LEDGER ORLANDO - Husband of Laura Virginia "Jinks" Bausman; Father of Lawrence Orlando and Charles Arthur Phillips; Son of Lawrence (or Peter) and Lydia Jane "Jennie" Courtwright Phillips Lussy; Brother of Zoe Estella "Stella", Celia Pearl, Myrtle, Orville, Orva and Lloyd Otto Phillips - Apr 4, 1884 - May 13, 1934

PHILLIPS, LENA MORRISON - (Mrs. Albert L. "Buffalo Bill" Phillips); Mother of Earl Phillips; Daughter of George Morrison; Sister-in-law of Frank Phillips - 1871 - Aug 24, 1901 - Age 30 Years – Lena died shortly before midnight from the bursting of a small vein at the base of her brain

PHILLIPS, LLOYD OTTO – Husband of Daisy Mae (or May) Seay; Son of Lawrence (or Peter) and Lydia Jane "Jennie" Courtwright Phillips (later Lussy); Brother of Orva, Celia Pearl, Myrtle, Zoe Estella "Stella" and Ledger Orlando Phillips – Sept 17, 1888 – Dec 22, 1945

Chivers and of Timothy Parker and Phebe Ann Hamlin Plantz; Great-grandson of Philip and Mary Nettleton Plantz and of Calvin and Catherine Smith Potter Hamlin - Feb 2, 1879 - 1892 - Charles died of typhoid fever. Both he and his brother, Ralph, came down with the disease after trying to repair a cesspool

POLLMAN, ALFRED A. - Flu - Husband of Lucy Krappo; Son of Henry William and Alice Pollman; Brother of Henry A., John Joseph and William F. Pollman and of Louise Pollman Savoren - 1893 - Oct 30, 1918 - Age 25 Years - Alfred and his wife, Lucy, died in the deadly flu epidemic

POLLMAN, LUCY KRAPPO - Flu - (Mrs. Alfred A. Pollman); Daughter of George Krappo; Sister of John and Charles Krappo - Dec 21, 1896 - Nov 7, 1918 - Age 21 Years - Eight days after the death of her husband in the devastating world-wide flu epidemic, Lucy joined him in the eternal sleep

PORTER, JONATHAN - Died Mar 20, 1884 - the appearance of a funeral procession wending its way on snowshoes to the resting place of the dead, was a spectacle seldom witnessed.

POWELL, MATTHEW CROWDER - Son of Calvin and Mary Barclay Powell; Uncle of William Way - Sept 1861 - July 13, 1922

POWELL, ROBERT - Died Mar 25, 1903 - Age 40 Years - Robert died of pneumonia after an illness of nine days duration, complicated by acute alcoholism

POWERS, FRED - Shot - Died July 1878
