RACHOVITCH - See Raickovich

RADAMACHER, JOHN "LONG JOHN" – Snowslide - Died Mar 10, 1884 - Age 34 Years - Long John was killed in a gigantic snowslide near Gladstone

RADEMACHER, RADMACHER - See Radamacher

IRADONICH, STEVE – Crushed to Death in Mine Accident - Son of Andria Radonich - Died July 29, 1906 - Age 48 Years

RAICKOVICH, MARKO S. - Flu - Son of Savo Raickovich; Relative of Milos Raickovich- March 1888 - Oct 20, 1918 - Age 30 Years - Marko died of flu at the Silverton hospital, one of more than forty persons who died during that week

RAICKOVICH, NICK (ROICINIC, NIKOLA) - Husband of Mary; Son of Steve Raickovich - Died April 23, 1919 - Age 35 Years

RALSTON, SETH - Died Dec 13, 1904 - Age 45 Years

RAMBO, WILLIAM E. - Blasting Accident - Civil War Veteran - Husband of Sarah; Brother of Benjamin Rambo- Died Aug 7, 1886 - Age 46 Years

RAMES, GEORGE - 1883 – 1887

RANCE, LEONARD H. – Son of Sarah Rance - Apr 1870 - Oct 17, 1890 - Age 20 Years – Accidentally Shot

RANDEL - See Randall

RANDICH, JOE - Son of Gregory and Mary Randich- July 13, 1890 - April 18, 1934

RAPP, BEN – Flu - Oct 14, 1882 - Nov 5, 1918 - All that was known of him was that he was born in San Francisco, California

RAVELLO - See Revello

RAYBAL - See Roybal

RAYNALDO, JOSEPH or RINO, JOE - 1891 - Dec 6, 1937

READ - Also See Reed, Reid

READ, GEORGIANA "ANNA" ISBELL - (Mrs. Arthur M. Read); Sister of I.H. Isbell - 1848 - Aug 10, 1884 - None knew her but to love her.

READER, ROBERT L. - Son of Gober Reader - Died Sept 4, 1906 - Age 35 Years - Robert, a miner, died of blood poisoning

REANY, MARY - (Also Known as Mary Woolcot) - Died Sept 21, 1889 - Age 26 Years - Mary, a Blair Street prostitute, died of liquor and abuse

RECTOR, A.A. - Scalded - (Mrs. Henry Brockman Rector); Mother of Jimmy Rector - 1840 - Aug 25, 1895 - Mrs. Rector, proprietor of the Capitol Hotel, died on a Sunday morning from the effects of a severe (and unexplained) scalding by hot water

RECTOR, HENRY BROCKMAN "OLD MAN RECTOR" - Husband of A.A. Rector; Father of Jimmy Rector - 1832 - Dec 10, 1900 - Patient, plodding, "Old Man Rector" passed on to his long account from the Alamo Hotel at 2:00 a.m. About four years before his death, Henry became a Christian

REDAMACHER - See Radamacher

REDWARD, CHARLES - Buried near Mineral Point - Died May 26, 1896 - Charley dropped dead about a mile above the San Juan Chief Mill

REECE - See Reese

REED - Also See Read, Reid

REED, JOHN - Died Sept 7, 1902 - Age 35 Years - John, a "Cousin Jack" miner from Cornwall, died in the early hours of a Sunday morning after being ill with acute lobar pneumonia four days; alcohol was also a contributing factor.

REED, RICHARD – Murdered - Died July 3, 1876 - An 1882, newspaper recalled that Richard was killed at Howardsville by George "Arkansaw" Johnson, a packer

REED, RUBY – Suicide by Shot In Head - Prostitute - Oct 4, 1868 - Oct 11, 1897

REESE, DEMPSEY - Son of Dempsey and Ann Ratliff Reese; Brother of Tom Reese - Sept 11, 1835 - Nov 13, 1890 - Dempsey Reese, one of Silverton's original founders, died at 2:00 p.m. on a Thursday of pneumonia and inflammation of the stomach

REESE, WILLIAM A. - 1859 - Feb 3, 1904

REGALIA, LUIGI (LOUIS) – Suicide by Shot in Head - Oct 6, 1848 - Nov 2, 1890 - A 45 Smith and Wesson was in his right hand and a small mirror in the left. The bullet entered just over the right ear and

came out the center of his forehead near the hairline. His skull was fractured in numerous places.

REID - Also spelled Read, Reed

REID, ALVA - Scarlet Fever - Son of Coleman C. and Myrtle Johnston Reid - Jan 17, 1901 - Jan 20, 1902 - Age 1 Year 3 Days. Little Alva came down with scarlet fever on his first birthday and died three days later

REID, STEPHEN - 1882 - Dec 4, 1931

REILLY - Also see Riley

REILLY, JAMES - Son of Michael and Agnes Hopkins Reilly; Brother of Lawrence and Thomas Reilly; Grandson of Lawrence and Mary Ann Reilly - Died Dec 29, 1912

REILLY, MICHAEL - Husband of Agnes Hopkins; Father of James, Lawrence, Tom and William Reilly; Son of Lawrence and Mary Ann Reilly - 1821 - March 27, 1905

REMORA, FRANK - Flu - Died Feb 16, 1919 - Age 20 Years - Due to another outbreak of flu in town, the emergency hospital was again set up. Frank, a miner at the Sunnyside, died there after being sick four days

RENDON, MARTINA "GRANDMA RENDON" - Mother of Mrs. Frank Jaramillo - Died Jan 15, 1927 - Age 65 Years

RENEHAN, MICHAEL - (also spelled Renehen, Renyhan)

No Marker - Died May 6, 1896 - Age 45 Years - Michael, an old time San Juaner, passed to the "eternal camping ground"

RENEHEN - See Renehan

RENNIS, ALBERT "AL" - 1855 - Apr 14, 1936

RENSLER, ADAM - Died July 19, 1898 - The county had been keeping Adam at Trembath's boarding house because he'd been "light in the upper story". Monday night he got away and was running up and down the alley in back of the newspaper office almost nude. The night watchman found him and placed him in safe keeping, and on Tuesday he died of delirium tremens

RENYHAN - See Renehan

REONDA, JIM - Died Apr 14, 1898 - Jim, an Italian, died from internal complications

RESEIGH, MATTHEW - Pneumonia - Husband of Honor Stratton Taylor; Father of Matthew, Jr., Lillie and Thomas Reseigh; Son of John and Elizabeth Eddy Reseigh; Brother of Thomas, William, John and Elizabeth "Bessie" Reseigh; Grandfather of Rhoda Eddy, John Hocking Eddy and Thomas Reseigh Eddy; Great-grandfather of Elvia Eddy Elbro, Joyce Eddy Trembath, Jean Eddy McLeod, James Graham Eddy and James Morris Eddy; Great-great grandfather of Penelope Jane Elbro (Richards) Cumming - May 1859 - June 26, 1904 - Age 45 Years - Matthew, born in St. Just, Penzance, Cornwall, died of pneumonia at the Barmouth Hotel after being ill about a week

RESS, MARIE - Daughter of August and Freda Cologna Ress - Died May 6, 1904 - Age 6 Hours

RESSOUCHES, LOUIS N. - Former husband of Rosalie Marie Pernot; Father of Clara, Julia, Marie and Olive Ressousches; Son of Laurent and Melanie Ressousches; Brother of Theophilus Ressousches - July 26, 1852 - Feb 1, 1932

RESSOUCHES, THEOPHILUS - Hit by a Rock - Husband of Marie; Father of Muriel Ressousches Montelius, Bertha Ressousches Kramer and Louis Ressousches; Son of Laurent and Melanie Ressousches; Brother of Louis Ressousches - 1850 - May 23, 1896

REUTHER - See Ruether

REVELLO, NINA CIMA - (Mrs. Paul Revello); Daughter of Peter and Domenica Giachetto Cima; Sister of Margherita Cima Lorenzon, and Lucy Cima Grivetto - Apr 6, 1870 - June 25, 1904

REW, JAMES CHARLES "CHARLEY" - Brother of Nettie Rew - Aug 1847 - Mar 5, 1931 - For many years he had been a living Silverton legend, known far and wide for his attire which always included straw hat and galoshes, every day of the year

REYNOLDS, DAVID BISHOP - June 3, 1934 - Jan 24, 2007

REYNOLDS, JAMES - Son of James and Bridget Fitzgerald Reynolds; Brother of Joe W. Reynolds - Jan 7, 1840 - Apr 14, 1906

REYNOLDS, JOE - Son of James and Bridget Fitzgerald Reynolds; Brother of James Reynolds - May 25, 1836 - Aug 26, 1915 - Joe, one of the old San Juan pioneers and a typical Rocky Mountain prospector, died at Miners Union Hospital in Silverton. He suffered with senile gangrene in his right leg, along with other problems related to his age.

REYNOLDS, MATTHEW "MATTIE" - Son of William Reynolds - 1860 - June 16, 1904

RHOADES, ALTA ALICE AUMILLER (MRS. CLIFFORD KENNETH RHOADES) - Mother of

Eugene, William Thomas "Billy" and James F. "Jimmy" Rhoades; Daughter of Clyde AuMiller and Frances Esther Jinkins AuMiller Cox; Sister of Harry and Clyde "Bud" AuMiller, Mrs. Audino Richardson and Marguerite AuMiller Bremen - Feb 10, 1903 - July 31, 1937

RHOADES, CLIFFORD KENNETH - Husband of Alta AuMiller and Elsie Davis; Father of Eugene, William Thomas "Billy" and Jimmy Rhoades - Nov 8, 1902 - May 24, 1969

ROADES, FADONA MAE PAYSON - Wife of William T. Rhoades; Mother of Butch and Terry Rhoades, Ladonna Rhoades Jaramillo, Beccy Rhoades, Daughter of Norman and Sophie Coon Payson - Jan 24, 1932 - Aug. 28, 2007

RHOADES, JAMES F. - Killed in Action in Korea - Son of Clifford Kenneth and Alta Alice AuMiller Rhoades; Brother of Eugene and William Thomas "Billy" Rhoades - Feb 6, 1930 - Aug 21, 1952

RHOADES, KENNETH EUGENE - Son of Clifford Kenneth and Alta Alice AuMiller Rhoades; Brother of James F. and William Thomas "Billy" Rhoades - Aug 1, 1923 - Dec 6, 1994

RHOADES, WILLIAM D. "BUTCH" - Husband of Kay Jenkins; Father of Kenneth Dean and Terry Layne Rodes; Son of William T. "Bill" and Fadona M. Payson Rhoades; Brother of Beccy and Terry Rhoades and LaDonna Rhoades Jaramillo; Grandson of Mr. and Mrs. Norman Payson - July 28, 1953 - July 28, 1979

RHOADES, WILLIAM T. (BILL) - Husband of Fadona M. Payson; Father of William (Butch), Terry and Beccy Rhoades and Ladonna Rhoades Jaramillo; Grandfather of Selene, Trent, Amos, Terry, Kenny, Tara, Krissy and Clint Rhoades Terry Rhoades, Deanna and Clifford Jaramillo; Great-grandfather of Dakota Rhoades; Son of Kenneth and Alma Aumiller Rhoades; Brother of Jimmy and Eugene Rhoades - Oct 28, 1928 - Sept 3, 1998

RHODDA, WILLIAM - Died Nov 2, 1902 - Age 45 Years - William, a native of Cornwall, England, expired suddenly from an attack of heart failure

RICE, ART - Snowslide - Son of Art and Mary Ann McGee Rice; Brother of Anna, Charles, Edwin, Felix, Frances, John, Patrick C., Susan and William Rice - 1875 - Dec 31, 1909 - Late Friday afternoon, news reached Silverton from Animas Forks that Art Rice, a prominent well known mining man of the district, had been caught in a huge snowslide on the side of Houghton Mountain near the Columbus Mine

RICE, JOHN "SHAKESPEARE" - Pneumonia - May Be Buried at Red Mountain - Died Feb 23, 1891 - A raging San Juan storm enveloped the mountains, and in Red Mountain the snow was twelve feet deep on the level. Big slides were down all over the county and everything was blockaded for two weeks. During the storm three men died of pneumonia at Red Mountain,

RICE, PATRICK C. - Pneumonia - Son of Art, Sr. and Mary Ann McGee Rice; Brother of Anna, Art, Charles, Edwin, Felix, Frances, John, Susan, and William Rice - Dec 24, 1874 - Aug 3, 1905

RICH, LEROY S. - Father of Bill, Frank, Jeanette and Jeannine Rich - April 7, 1918 - Sept 15, 1980

RICHARDS, HARRY - See Richards, John - Died 1898 - was first identified as "Harry", but the name was later corrected to "John" Richards

RICHARDS, HENRY - Brother of Alfred Richards - 1857 - May 5, 1891 - For two weeks he had been suffering with a toothache, then walked around for several hours one evening and caught a bad cold. From that he developed pneumonia, was compelled to take to his bed, and soon breathed his last, surrounded by his friends

RICHARDS, INFANT BOY - Son of Alfred and Helen Knucky Richards - Dec 6, 1890 - Dec 8, 1890 - Age 2 Days - Death stepped in and claimed this firstborn child who was born on Saturday and died on Monday

RICHARDS, JOHN "JOHNNIE" - Blasting Accident - Died May 21, 1898 - Age 25 Years - The sad news was carried to town that through one of those unaccountable accidents, Johnnie was instantly killed by a premature blast at the Silver Lake Mine

RICHARDS, WILLIAM HENRY - Killed by Rock Slide in Mine - 1859 - Jan 29, 1889 - Age 30 Years - William was working at timbering in a stope of the Yankee Girl Mine when he was instantly killed by a rock slide which engulfed and crushed him

RICHARDSON, BRETT DEAN - Veteran - Husband of Ruth Salazar; Father of Shannon Richardson; Son of Beverly Richardson; Grandson of Opal Nance - June 10, 1949 - Dec 1, 1977

RICHARDSON, MATT - Died Apr 6, 1906 - Age 60 Years - Matt, a pauper and old time resident of the San Juan District, died suddenly at Kemp's Hospital on a Saturday morning. He suffered from tuberculosis and mitral insufficiency

RICKARD, MAY - Alcoholism or Morphine - Prostitute - Died Jan 10, 1899
RICKARD, SOLOMON - (Or Rickerd, Sahrion) - Died Dec 10, 1905 - Age 46 Years - Solomon died of pneumonia on a Sunday morning
RICO - See Rigo
RIGO, DECIMO - See Decimo
RILEY - Also See Reilly, O'Reilly
RILEY, EDWARD - Died May 5, 1901 - Age 37 Years
RILEY, JAMES - See Reilly, James
RILEY, JAMES K. - Died Nov 22, 1905 - Age 58 Years
RINO, JOE - See Raynaldo, Joseph
RISDON, ROSA BROWN - "Grandma Risdon" - Mother of Raymond, Blanche, Elva, Emma and Mabel Risdon - Apr 16, 1846 - Feb 13, 1920
RITH, VICTORIA FRANCES - Daughter of William and Dorella Cushing Rith - Feb 6, 1916 - Feb 10, 1916
RITTER, HARRY JOHN - Husband of Mattie Record; Father of Robert Earl Ritter; Son of Phillip Lyman and Caroline Divel Ritter - Sept 24, 1873 - July 4, 1914 - Harry died of ruptured appendix and peritonitis
RITTER, ROBERT EARL - Son of Harry John and Mattie Record Ritter - Apr 4, 1906 - May 8, 1906 - Age 1 Month - Robert, the infant son of Harry and Mattie Ritter, suffered two days with acute gastritis and meningitis before he died at the family home
RITTERBUSH, LORETTA JUNE - Daughter of Frank Edward and Henrietta Florence Way Ritterbush; Granddaughter of William Alvis and Hazel Henrietta Fletcher Way and of Mildred Ritterbush - June 1, 1941 - May 13, 1942 - Age 11 Months - *With the Angels*
ROACH, JAMES (or JOE) - Died Sept 24, 1896 - Jim died at the Trembath Boarding House in Silverton from either pneumonia or a disease resulting from impurity of the blood
ROACH, MORRIS - Snowslide - Died Jan 29, 1894 - The last time Roach was seen alive was on January 29th, when he left Silverton, headed for Ophir. In May of the following spring, his body was uncovered in a snowslide, in a standing position with one hand in his hip pocket
ROAT, DAVID - Fractured Skull - Son of Matt Roat - 1889 - June 23, 1930 - Age 41 Years - David unexpectedly met death when he walked out the door of the tram house at the Sunnyside Mill, fell ten or twelve feet to the rocks below and crushed his skull. He never regained consciousness
ROATCAP, ELDA JEAN - Daughter of Emery and Mary B. Clark Roatcap - Died December 26, 1937 - This little girl was stillborn
ROBBINS, ERCCELL - Flu - Daughter Frank and Una McCain Robbins (later Hinkley); Granddaughter of Columbus and Camilla Frances Warnick McCain- Sept 15, 1898 - Oct 26, 1918 - Age 20 Years - This lovely young girl lost her life in the cruel and devastating flu epidemic. The grim reaper entered the family home at 1032 Snowden and claimed as its forfeit her life
ROBBINS, MARY ANNE KILKENNY - (Mrs. Frank Robbins #1); Mother of Vincent, Irene and Roy J. Robbins and Child born 1895 - Nov 2, 1855 - Mar 17, 1895 - The cause of her sad demise was childbirth
ROBELEAU - See Robillard
ROBERTS, EBENEZER L. "EBBIE" - Son of Ebenezer L. "Bob" and Emma "Lizzie" Smith Roberts; Brother of Elgey, Daney, Verdie, Edris and Alvie Roberts; Grandson of Owen and Laura Roberts - Oct 16, 1891 - Sept 17, 1892 - Age 11 Months
ROBERTS, FLORENCE - Childbirth - (Mrs. William C. Roberts) - 1864 - Aug 2, 1887 - Age 23 Years
ROBERTS, GEORGE - 1853 - 1895
ROBERTS, JOHN "THE PRINCE OF WALES" - Died Nov 15, 1905 - Age 60 Years - John, better known as "The Prince of Wales", died of pneumonia and drunkenness.
ROBERTS, LAURA - (Mrs. Owen Roberts) - Mother of Ebenezer L. "Bob", Robert W. and Maggie Roberts and Gwen Roberts Jones Jenkins - April 1810 - June 30, 1899 - Age 89 Years - A chapter completed, a page turned, A life well lived, a rest well earned.
ROBERTS, ROBERT W. - Snowslide - Husband of Jane; Father of Laura, Robert, Owen and Evan Roberts; Son of Laura and Owen Roberts - Dec 21, 1855 - Apr 19, 1886 - Age 31 Years - The headlines in the newspaper proclaimed the terrible work of the death-dealing avalanche
ROBERTS, THEO - 1856 - 1894
ROBILLARD, JOSEPH - Father of Bertha Bridget Robillard Landry and Emma Robillard Bagozzi? - 1856 - July 26, 1906

ROBIN, AMELIA MARY ROBERTS - (Mrs. James H. Robin); Mother of Maud Isabel, Edith and Arthur James Robin - 1855 - Feb 25, 1913

ROBIN, ARTHUR G. - Electrocuted - Son of Nicholas and Esther E. Hutchinson Robin; Brother or Half-brother of Charles E. "Bob", Edward Matthews, George E., James H., Ted, Isabella A. "Belle" and Susan D.J. "Susie" Robin - Sept 22, 1862 - Feb 2, 1917 - Art, the compressor man at the Pride of the West Mine, was accidentally electrocuted when inspecting a defect in the transformer house

ROBIN, GEORGE E. - Suicide by Drowning - Son of Nicholas and Esther E. Hutchinson Robin; Brother or Half-brother of Art G., Charles E. "Bob", Edward Matthews, James H., Ted, Isabella A. "Belle" and Susan D.J. "Susie" Robin - Nov 19, 1849 - Apr 9, 1907 - George was last seen in town on Monday night; on Wednesday morning the conductor on the incoming Denver & Rio Grande freight discovered his body in the Animas River, lodged between boulders, near milepost 492

ROBIN, JAMES H. - Suicide by Gunshot after Bank Failure - Husband of Amelia Mary Roberts; Father of Maud Isabel, Edith, and Arthur James Robin; Son of Nicholas and Esther E. Hutchinson Robin; Brother or Half-brother of Art G., Charles E. "Bob", Edward Matthew, George E., Isabella "Belle", Susie and Ted Robin - May 10, 1851 - Jan 1, 1903 - As the freight train from Durango stopped at the tank for water, one of the men found Jim's body in a partly sitting position against one of the supports of the tank. A ragged bullet hole above the right ear showed where the cruel bullet had done its fatal work.

ROBIN, MAUD ISABEL - Daughter of James H. and Amelia Roberts Robin; Sister of Edith and Arthur James Robin; Granddaughter of Nicholas and Esther E. Hutchison Robin - Mar 14, 1883 - Sept 19, 1883 - Age 6 Months - Little Maud, who died of cholera infantum, was the firstborn child of Jim and Amelia.

ROBINSON, DONALD GENE - Son of Donald Dave "Keso" and Jean Swanson Robinson; Brother of Mike, Mary and Julie Robinson; Grandson of Irwin and Mary Dalla Swanson and of Cleeburn C. and Hazel L. McCluer Robinson - Apr 2, 1954 - Sept 20, 1979 *Death separates us, memories bind us; we are apart, but we are together.*

ROBINSON, HARLEY LEROY - Son of Claude and Irene Groff Robinson; Brother of Barbara Robinson Carver Starkey and Dan Robinson - May 16, 1937 - Jan 20, 1938 - Age 8 Months

ROBINSON, HAZEL LEE MCCLUER - Daughter of David L. and Anna Wommer McCluer; Sister of David Henry "Sus" and Timothy Jacob McCluer and of Juanita Elizabeth McCluer Brightwell Powell - 1911 - Dec 5, 1937

ROBINSON, WILLIAM - Died Oct 23, 1911 - Age 76 Years

ROCKWOOD, ZAIDEE MARIAN GROUT - (Mrs. Thomas Rockwood); Mother of Zaidée Evangeline Rockwood; Daughter of Isaac Endrass and Caroline Anderson Grout; Sister of Medora Irene and Frank Herbert Grout - Aug 21, 1859 - Sept 13, 1879 - Age 20 Years - Zaidée, who only a year before was a happy bride, died from puerperal fever, also called child-bed fever

ROCROFT - See Rowcroft

RODAKOVITZ - See Roy - Name was legally changed

RODAMACHER - See Radamacher

RODDY, WILLIAM - See Rhodda, William

RODGERS - See Rogers - Spellings were often used interchangeably; all are referenced here as "Rogers".

RODINE, "DOC" - Died Oct 5, 1893

ROFF, HARVEY LEROY "ROY" - Husband of Ellen Lewis Rowlands Charles; Father of Curtis P. Roff; Son of Frank S. and Hattie Meeker Roff; Brother of Mabel Roff Ripley - Dec 11, 1881 - Jan 11, 1957

ROGACH - See Rogash

ROGASH, JAMES - Cousin of George Muisich - 1895 - Dec 19, 1926 - Age 31 Years - Jim died of silicosis (miners con)

ROGERS, ALBERT E. "BERT" - Froze to Death - Son of Charles Stockton and Mary Hamilton DeHines Rogers; Brother of Charles Rogers, Jr.; Half-brother of John DeHines; Grandson of George and Sarah Stockton Rogers- Sept 14, 1889 - Nov 11, 1911 - Age 22 Years - Bert froze to death on Molas Pass, the victim of the same San Juan blizzard which ultimately also claimed John Dalla

ROGERS, CHARLES STOCKTON, JR. - Son of Charles Stockton Rogers, Sr., and Mary Hamilton DeHines Rogers; Brother of Bert Rogers; Half-brother of John DeHines - 1886 - June 12, 1897 - Age 11 Years

ROGERS, CHARLES STOCKTON, SR. - Husband of Mary Hamilton DeHines Rogers; Father of Charles, Jr. and Bert Rogers; Step-father of John DeHines; Son of George and Sarah Stockton Rogers; Brother of Craig M. Rogers- March 17, 1839 - July 19, 1904 - Charles, an old respected citizen and well known restaurant man of Silverton, died in a way that was heartrending

ROGERS (RODGERS), CLARA - Daughter of John M. "Jack" and Jennie Elizabeth Porter Rogers; Sister of Frank and Harry Rogers - Dec 21, 1877 - Aug 20, 1880 - Age 2 Years 8 Months - The newspaper was "pained to be compelled to chronicle the death of little Clara"

ROGERS, FRANK - Drowned - Son of John M. "Jack" and Jennie Elizabeth Porter Rogers; Sister of Clara and Harry Rogers - Nov 2, 1884 - July 24, 1903 - Age 18 Years - Frank was drowned in Fisher's Pond at the east end of 14th Street

ROGERS, HARRY PORTER - Son of John M. "Jack" and Jennie Elizabeth Porter Rogers; Brother of Clara and Frank Rogers - Apr 18, 1882 - Dec 5, 1953

ROGERS, J. WESLEY "SALESMAN SAM" - Son of J.R. and Martha Rogers - July 19, 1878 - July 8, 1935 - About thirty minutes after midnight, between Silverton and Howardsville, his car plunged over a cliff 125 feet down to the railroad tracks

ROGERS, JENNIE ELIZABETH PORTER - (Mrs. John M. "Jack" Rogers); Mother of Clara, Frank and Harry Rogers; Daughter of Robert L. and Elizabeth Porter - Mar 29, 1851 - Apr 3, 1930 - Jennie died at Durango's Oschner Hospital after suffering ten years with heart trouble and chronic nephritis

ROGERS, JOHN M. "JACK" (RODGERS) - Husband of Jennie Elizabeth Porter; Father of Clara, Harry and Frank Rogers; Son of John and Elizabeth "Betsey" Perry Rogers - Dec 31, 1845 - July 31, 1913

ROGERS, LOUIS - See Flores, Louis

ROGERS, MARY HAMILTON DEHINES - (Mrs. Charles Stockton Rogers, Sr.); Mother of John Dehines, Charles, Jr. and Bert Rogers - Died May 18, 1916 - Age 55 Years

ROGERS (RODGERS), RICHARD "DICK" - Son of John Rogers; Brother of William C. and Frank Rogers, Mrs. John Casey and Mrs. Catherine Sheene - 1852 - Jan 19, 1925

ROGERS, WILLIS - Son of William Charles and Mary Frances O'Sullivan Rogers; Brother of John F., Thomas Joseph and Alexis William Rogers and of Mrs. George Chouinard - Jan 28, 1901 - Aug 23, 1901 - Age 6 Months 26 Days

ROHRIG, EMMA PETERS - (Mrs. Reinhold Herbert "Louie" Rohrig #2) - Mother of Violet and Herb Rohrig - Aug 1854 - Oct 16, 1889 - Age 35 Years - *Into thy hands I commend my spirit*

ROHRIG, INFANT - Child of Reinhold Herbert "Louie" and Emma Peters Rohrig - Died May 1, 1885 - It was with deep regret that the many friends of Reinhold and Emma Rohrig heard of the misfortune which overtook them at a moment when they were about to have their fondest hopes realized by the birth of a child. The baby was stillborn

ROICINIC, NIKOLA - See Raickovich, Nick

ROLAND, JACKSON T. - 1868 - 1907

ROMAN, AGOSTINO - Cousin of Monteo Roman - Died Jan 1, 1897 - Age 41 Years

ROMAN, LOUIS C. - Son of Valentine and Madeline Giacomelli Roman - 1866 - Sept 5, 1905 - Age 39 Years - Louis was found dead in his bed at the Silver Lake Mine

ROMANO, GIUSEPPE (JOE) - Flu - Died Oct 21, 1918 - Age 39 Years - Joe died of flu at the emergency hospital set up in the Silverton Town Hall

ROMERO, EDMUNCINO (EDWARD) - Flu - Died Oct 23, 1918 - Age 35 Years - After being very ill four days, Edmuncino, a Mexican miner, succumbed to the deadly flu at the Sunnyside Mine boarding house

ROMERO, FRANK - Flu - Died Feb 16, 1919 - Age 20 Years - Frank, born in New Mexico, died of Spanish influenza.

ROMERO, GEORGE - Husband of Maria de la Luz Montoya "Lucy"; Father of Della, Glenda, Georgann, Berna, Melva, Marlene and Eli Romero; Son of Natividad Romero - Feb 2, 1923 - Feb 27, 1995

ROMERO, MARIA DE LA LUZ MONTOYA "LUCY"
Wife of George Romero, Mother of Della Romero, Glenda Romero, Georgann Romero Valdez, Bernadette Romero Ernst, Melva Jean Romero Caveness, Marlene Romero Archuleta and Eli Romero, Daughter of Fermin and Delubina Montoya - July 25, 1928 - Dec 8, 2002

ROMERO, VICKIE ANN LISA - Daughter of Victor, Jr. and Ruby Connie Lopez Romero - June 29, 1959 - Sept 17, 1959 - Age 2 Months 19 Days

RONER, JAMES - Son of Andrew Roner - Died July 26, 1909 - Age 44 Years - While on his way to the Highland Mary mine, where he had secured employment, James was suddenly taken with a hemorrhage of the lungs and died before medical aid could be summoned

ROOD, ODIE - Died Jan 30, 1911 - Age 40 Years

ROPER, INFANT BOY - Son of John Franz and Nora Mount Roper - Died July 1907 - The infant son of John and Nora lived only a short time after his birth.

ROSA or ROSADAS, LUIGI - Son of Angelo and Lucia Rosa - 1857 - Mar 22, 1906 - Age 19 Years - Luigi, a prominent young Italian, died of pneumonia

ROSA, PETER - Died Aug 30, 1898 - Age 19 Years

ROSENSTOCK, INFANT BOY - Son of Christian R. "Christie" and Stella Sharp Rosenstock; Nephew of Sara Rosenstock Hill, Frances Rosenstock Reed and Edward Alvin and Minnie Sharp Hillman; Great-grandson of Samuel and Amanda Hillman - Died July 16, 1918 - This little boy was stillborn at Miners Union Hospital

ROSS, JOHN E. - Feb 18, 1937 - Sept 11, 2009

ROSS, FLOYD W. - Died 1943; Buried 1997 - Dec 27, 1881 - Oct 15, 1943 - Floyd's cremated remains were found in the former Maguire mortuary establishment in 1996, and subsequently buried at Hillside.

ROSS, MASDEN CLAYTON MUIR - Typhoid Fever - Son of W.B. and Jessica Muir Ross - July 23, 1910 - Feb 4, 1919 - Age 8-1/2 Years

ROSS, STELLA, MRS. - See Crowley, Maggie

ROSSEN - See Rosson

ROSSI, STEFANO - Mine Accident - Died Jan 27, 1909 - Age 28 Years

ROSSMAN, JOHN - Flu - Died Oct 29, 1918 - Age 29 Years

ROSSON, W.G. "SHORTY" - Flu - Husband of Vic Wilson - Died Oct 25, 1918 - Age 44 Years

ROUANE - See Ruane

ROWCROFT, MINNIE - Frozen - (Mrs. Thomas "Professor" Rowcroft) - Died Jan 15, 1888 - Age 35 Years - On a Sunday morning Minnie's body was found at her home on Mineral Street, frozen stiff in death

ROWE, FLORENCE A. GIBSON (Mrs. John M. Rowe) - Typhoid Fever and Pneumonia - Sister of Mrs. R.M. Maupin - June 25, 1893 - Nov 13, 1915

ROY - Shortened from Rodakovitz

ROY, THEODORE ROBERT "TEDDY" - Fell from Cliff - Son of Alfonzo Frank "Dutch" and Ann Arietta Roy (Rodakovitz); Brother of Alfonzo Frank, Jr. and Raymond Roy and Grace Ann Roy Lappin - July 2, 1944 - May 6, 1960 - Age 15 Years - Teddy was instantly killed when he fell from a 350 foot cliff in Boulder Creek Canyon, near Silverton

ROYBAL, RUBEL - Son of Adolph and Ferminia Jaramillo Roybal - April 29, 1925 - Dec 28, 1927 - Age 2 Years 8 Months

ROYBAL, PORFIRIO - Flu - Died Oct 24, 1918 - Porfirio died of flu at the Sunnyside Mine

RUANE, JAMES J. "JIMMY" - First Flu Death in County - Son of Anthony and Mary Quinn (or Guinn) Ruane; Brother of Annie Ruane Hennigan, John, Mike, Patrick and Tony Ruane - 1884 - Oct 18, 1918

RUDELLAT, INFANT BOY - Son of Peter and Domenica Vota Perino Rudellat - Feb 1900 - Sept 26, 1900 - Age 7 Months - The icy finger of death touched the eyelids of this little boy, and the child slept.

RUETHER, HARRY ARCHIE "SLIM" (Also known as Harry Oswald) - Husband of Viola Holmes (later Curtis); Father of Evelyn Ruether; Son of Henry and Ester Kinghorn Ruether - Apr 12, 1906 - Apr 27, 1949

RUSSELL, J.K. - Died Dec 14, 1905 - Age 67 Years - The black robed angel of death hovered over Silverton and left mourning in many homes. Between Saturday noon and Thursday noon ten persons answered the summons to the Great Beyond

RUTHERFORD, JULIAN - Stillborn - Son of Paul and Julia Lewis Rutherford - Died Mar 24, 1931

RUSSIAN PRINCESS - See Harris, Emma

RYAN, ED F. - Snowslide - Died Dec 30, 1881 - Three men, Ed Ryan, Mike Ryan and Richard Atkins were killed in an avalanche at the Paradise Tunnel on Lookout Mountain

RYAN, JERRY C. - Father of Claude, Frank, A.D. and D.J. Ryan - Died May 27, 1887 - Age 39 Years - The people of Silverton were greatly surprised to learn that Jerry had died of pneumonia

RYAN, JOHN "JACK" - Died Apr 5, 1906 - Age 40 Years - Jack died of pneumonia

RYAN, KATE (MRS. JOHN H. RYAN) - Sister of Mrs. John McMillan - Died Jan 2, 1905 - Buried at Red Mountain

RYAN, MICHAEL - Snowslide - Died Dec 30, 1881 - Michael was killed in an avalanche at the Paradise Tunnel on Lookout Mountain. Killed in the same slide were Ed F. Ryan and Richard Atkins
