**SACHLETTI, JOE** - Died June 14, 1926 - Age 54 Years - "Apparently the man just lay down and died".

**SAEGEL, ANGELO** - Fell over Cliff - Died Aug 14, 1901 - Age 45 Years - The lifeless body of Angelo, an Austrian miner, was found at the foot of the high cliff above the Iowa Mill

**SAENGER, ANTON A.** - Suicide - Husband of Mary; Father of Sylvester Wes, Tony, Bertha Beatrice, Emma, Florence and Mary Saenger - June 7, 1857 - Jan 7, 1913 – Suicide - Anton, a highly respected miner and citizen, died suddenly at 6:30 a.m. from a self inflicted gunshot wound over his heart

**SAENGER, JACOB ANDREW** - Son of Christian and Marie Saenger; Brother of Alice Saenger Miller, Margaret and P.J. Saenger; Uncle of Rita Miller; Cousin of Gus Malchus - Oct 11, 1854 - Dec 5, 1930

**SAENGER, MARY R.** - (Mrs. Anton A. Saenger); Mother of Sylvester Wes, Tony, Bertha Beatrice, Emma, Florence and Mary Saenger - 1860 - Dec 22, 1909 - She died in Denver's Union Station as she was waiting to take the Silverton bound train

**SAILA, THOMAS** - See Sala, Thomas

**SAINT CLAIR** - See St. Clair

**SALA, THOMAS** - Snowslide - Also referred to as Thomas Saila and A. Tomaso - Son of Augustino and Maria Fazutti Sala; Brother of Celestine (Cecil) Sala - Apr 27, 1878 - Jan 22, 1906, 8:00 a.m. - On a Monday morning at the new Terry Tunnel of the Sunnyside Mine, six miners were working at the mouth of the tunnel when a snowslide suddenly crashed down the mountain, covered up the six men and carried five of them to their deaths

**SALAZAR, ANDRES “ANDREW” RAYMOND** - Son of Jose “Joe” Eusebio and Manuelita Archuleta Salazar; Brother of Ruth Maryann, Catherine Elizabeth “Katy”, Mary, Bernardino “Benny” and Ruben Ernest Salazar; Grandson of Jose Bernardo and Maria Labriana Asenaida Mestas Salazar; Great-Grandson of Jose Eusebio Salazar and Amadita Garcia Salazar - Dec 4, 1947 - Nov 11, 1972

**SALAZAR, GEORGE FLORENTINO** - Electrocuted - Son of Jose Doroteo "Joe D." and Mary (Maria) Delubina Candelaria Salazar; Brother of Laura Salazar Stultz, Anita Salazar Pausa, Ila Mary, Ole, Jerry, Horace, Joe Isador, Joe D., Jr., Walter and Walter Salazar (both died in infancy); Grandson of Raman Salazar - Jan 8, 1930 - Oct 2, 1945

**SALAZAR, GILBERT** - Son of Fermin R. and Romcito Archuletta Salazar - Died May 1, 1950 - Age 1 Day

**SALAZAR, HORACE** - Son of Jose Doroteo "Joe D." and Mary (Maria) Delubina Candelaria Salazar; Brother of Laura Salazar Stultz, Anita Salazar Pausa, Ila Mary, Ole, Jerry, George, Joe Isador, Joe D., Jr., Walter and Walter (both died in infancy) Salazar - July 6, 1922 - Apr 13, 1992

**SALAZAR, ILA MARY** - Daughter of Jose Doroteo "Joe D." and Mary (Maria) Delubina Candelaria Salazar; Sister of Laura Salazar Stultz, Anita Salazar Pausa, Ole, Jerry, George Florentino, Horace, Joe Isador, Joe D., Jr., Walter and Walter (both died in infancy) Salazar - Apr 6, 1932 - Jan 25, 1977

**SALAZAR, JOSE DOROTEO "JOE D."** - Husband of Maria Delubina Candelaria; Father of Laura Salazar Stultz, Anita Salazar Pausa, Ila Mary, Ole, Jerry, George Florentino, Horace, Joe Isador, Joe D., Jr., Walter and Walter (both died in infancy) Salazar; Son of Raman Salazar - Feb 6, 1898 - Sept 25, 1988

**SALAZAR, JOE E.** – Mill Accident - Husband of Manuelita "Mannie" Archuleta; Father of Andres “Andrew” Raymond Salazar, Ruth Maryann Salazar Richardson, Catherine Elizabeth “Katy” Salazar Martinez (later Murray), Mary Salazar Quintana, Bernardino “Benny” and Ruben Ernest Salazar; Son of Jose Bernardo and Maria Labriana Asenaida Mestas Salazar; Grandson of Jose Eusebio Salazar and Amadita Garcia Salazar- April 30, 1917 - Mar 2, 1972 - Joe E. was killed in a tragic accident at the Standard Metals Mill, where he was shift boss

**SALAZAR, MARY (MARIA) DELUBINA CANDELARIA** - (Mrs. Jose Doroteo "Joe D." Salazar); Mother of Laura Salazar Stultz, Anita Salazar Pausa, Ila Mary, Ole, Jerry, George Florentino, Horace, Joe Isador, Joe D., Jr., Walter and Walter (both died in infancy) Salazar; Daughter of Bidal Candelaria - Apr 1902 - Feb 24, 1978

**SALAZAR, TERRY ZANE** - Son of Jose Isadore "Joe I." and Stella Margaret Sandoval Salazar; Grandson of Joe D. and Maria Delubina Candelaria Salazar - Nov 4, 1943 - Jan 19, 1944 - Age 2 Months 15 Days

**SALETTI, JOE "JOE THE PACKER"** - Son of Louis and Katie Morello Saletto - Sept 26, 1892 - May 16, 1934

**SALFISBERG, FRANCIS ADAIR "BUTCH"** - Shot - Son of Francis Wielang "Deacon" and Helen Marie Gillespie Salfisberg; Brother of Roberta Loudel, Mildred Marie and Daniel Richard Salfisberg - Jan

14, 1942 - Apr 19, 1951 - Age 9 Years

**SALFISBERG, FRANCIS WIELANG "DEACON"** - Husband of Helen Marie Gillespie and Nona Emma Willey Vota Barlow; Father of Roberta Loudel Salfisberg Fletcher, Mildred Marie Salfisberg Knodel, Francis Adair "Butch" and Daniel Richard Salfisberg; Son of Fred and Mary Wielang Salfisberg; Grandson of Joseph and Agatha Sieffert Wielang - Mar 13, 1911 - June 4, 1980

**SALFISBERG, FREDERICK** - Husband of Marie (Mary) Wielang; Father of Frederick Jr., Joseph Francis, Agatha Catherine, Robert Samuel, Unnamed Infant Boy; Hubert W., Francis Wielang and Alice Mae Salfisberg - Apr 28, 1862 - Dec 27, 1926

**SALFISBERG, HELEN GILLESPIE** - (Mrs. Francis Wielang "Deacon" Salfisberg #1); Mother of Roberta Loudel Salfisberg Fletcher, Mildred Marie Salfisberg Knodel, Francis Adair "Butch" and Daniel Richard "Pip" Salfisberg; Daughter of Andrew J. Gillespie and Mildred Place Gillespie (later Berkey, Cram); Half-Sister of Art Berkey, Jr.; Granddaughter of Mr. and Mrs. Daniel E. Place; Great-granddaughter of Mrs. M.S. Stark - June 9, 1913 - Oct 25, 1974

**SALFISBERG, HUBERT W.** - Son of Frederick and Marie (Mary) Wielang Salfisberg; Brother of Fred Jr., Joseph Francis, Robert Samuel, Unnamed Infant Boy and Francis Wielang Salfisberg and of Agatha Catherine Salfisberg Peterson and Alice Mae Salfisberg Kornafel - Mar 23, 1908 - Aug 10, 1933 - While attempting to correct a battery failure during a radio program at station KVOA in Tucson, Arizona, Hubert came in contact with a transformer. More than 4,000 volts of electricity passed through his body and death was almost instantaneous.

**SALFISBERG, INFANT BOY** - Son of Frederick and Marie (Mary) Wielang Salfisberg; Brother of Fred Jr., Joseph Francis, Robert Samuel, Hubert W. and Francis Wielang Salfisberg and of Agatha Catherine Salfisberg Peterson and Alice Mae Salfisberg Kornafel - Apr 16, 1906 - Apr 19, 1906 - Age 3 Days

**SALFISBERG, JOSEPH FRANCIS** - Tramway Accident - Son of Frederick and Mary Wielang Salfisberg; Brother of Fred Jr., Robert Samuel, Unnamed Infant Boy, Hubert W. and Francis Wielang Salfisberg, Agatha Catherine Salfisberg Peterson and Alice Mae Salfisberg Kornafel - Sept 25, 1900 - Sept 19, 1927 - Jolly and faithful Joe, second son of Fred and Marie (Mary) Salfisberg, was the third member of the family to go down to death within nine months

**SALFISBERG, MARIE (MARY) F. WIELANG** - (Mrs. Frederick Salfisberg, Sr.); Mother of Fred Jr., Joseph Francis, Robert Samuel, Infant Boy Unnamed, Hubert W., Francis Wielang Salfisberg, Agatha Catherine Salfisberg Peterson and Alice Mae Salfisberg Kornafel; Daughter of Joseph and Agatha Sieffert Wielang; Sister of Anthony and Joseph Franklin Wielang - Jan 27, 1881 - Jan 16, 1932 - Mary's decline in health was directly traced to the untimely death of her husband in late 1926, and the tragic deaths of two of her sons within nine months of her husband's death

**SALFISBERG, NONA EMMA WILLEY VOTA BARLOW** - Feb 6, 1909 - Jan 29, 2000 - Mother of JoAnn Vota Sandell Hinman and Billy Lee Barlow

**SALFISBERG, ROBERT SAMUEL** - Snowslide - Son of Fred and Marie (Mary) Wielang Salfisberg; Brother of Fred Jr., Joseph Francis, Infant Boy Unnamed, Hubert W. and Francis Wielang Salfisberg, Agatha Catherine Salfisberg Peterson and Alice Mae Salfisberg Kornafel - Dec 17, 1904 - Feb 18, 1927

**SALFISBERG, SALLY LOIS KANE** - (Mrs. Daniel Richard "Pip" Salfisberg) - Apr 26, 1948 - April 8, 1997

**SAMILS, IMANTS "SAM"** - Suicide - Son of Nikolaf V. Samils and Milda Leonovs - Nov 9, 1941 - July 27, 1985

**SAMORA, EDDIE MAX** - Drowned - Son of Max Ignacio and Lupe Armenta Samora; Brother of Grace, Virginia, Betty, Mary Ann, Lupe, Helen, Leo, Ben, Rudy, Gene and Jimmy Samora - Mar 26, 1944 - May 14, 1947 - Age 3 Years

**SAMORA, JOHN** - Infant Son of Roseldo and Margie Lobato Samora - Died Nov 26, 1945 - Age 8 Hours

**SAMS, JOHN PRICE "RED"** - Husband of Nora Mullen McDonald (later Bolen); Son of Asa and Fannie Armstrong Sams; Brother of David, James and Roy Sams - Feb 19, 1893 - Mar 28, 1934

**SANDAVAL** - See Sandoval

**SANDELL, WILLIAM GLEN "SANDY"** - Husband of Mildred White; Father of Thomas Glenn and Jerry Sandell; Son of William Harold Sandell; Brother of Dewey Sandell and Lucille Sandell Berridge - July 13, 1908 - Nov 27, 1988

**SANDER, ADAM** - Died Dec 30, 1896 - Adam was knocked down and fatally injured by a team of horses

**SANDERS** - Also See Saunders

**SANDERS, AUGUST "GUS"** - (Also referred to as "Gus Lundine") - Brother of Mary Sanders Pierson - Died July 28, 1908

**SANDERS or SAUNDERS, BELLE J. KLEPP RECORD** - (Mrs. Al Sanders, formerly Mrs. William Record); Mother of Mattie Record (later Ritter) and Minta C. Record Doss (Mrs. William T. Doss); Daughter of Edward and Mattie Woods Klepp - Oct 30, 1845 - Mar 15, 1903

**SANDERS or SAUNDERS, EVA** - Negro – Pneumonia - Daughter of Rev. J.W. and C.M. Bolden Sanders - Mar 1, 1905 - Mar 24, 1906 - Age 1 Year

**SANDERS or SAUNDERS, GEORGE** - Died May 24, 1925 - Age 63 Years - George had come into town because he wasn't feeling well, and walked from the depot to Doctor Bryan's office, then to the Alma House. He registered, went to his room and died. Dr. Bryan noted the cause of death was clogged bowels.

**SANDOVAL, MERIJILDO** - Died Sept 11, 1930 - Age 45 Years - Merijildo, a sheepherder, was found dead on September 13th near the telephone cabin on the old Durango highway

**SANTISTEVAN, INFANT** - Died June 22, 1956 - This baby was stillborn

**SAPP, VICTOR** - Fell from Tram - Jan 1, 1884 - Aug 20, 1917 - Age 32 Years - Victor, an employee of the Iowa Tiger Mining Company, was working as an oiler on the tramway when he fell two hundred feet

**SARCHLETTI, RODOLFO** - Snowslide - Died Feb 11, 1905 - Age 25 Years - Rodolfo Sarchletti and Pete Casagrande, both hard working Austrian miners, met sudden and instant death in an unexpected snowslide.

**SARTORE, ANGELINA DIGHERA** - (Mrs. Joseph Sartore) - Mother of Mary and Philip Amerigo Sartore; Daughter of Luigi and Agelina Dighera; Sister of Lucia Dighera Baudino; Grandmother of Joseph Vota; Aunt of Jim Baudino and Lena Baudino Dalla) - Jan 9, 1859 - Apr 19, 1931

**SARTORE, ANGELINA GIORDANO** - (Mrs. Louis Sartore) - Mother of Jennie Sartore Bonavida, Kate Sartore Baudino and Philip Joseph Sartore; Daughter of Dominic and Katrina Marlo Giordano - July 7, 1859 - Oct 22, 1918

**SARTORE, ANGELO** - Shot - Son of Frank and Theresa Gobbia Sartore - 1879 - July 13, 1906 - Angelo, referred to in one newspaper as a professional horse thief, was shot and fatally wounded while trying to get away with a string of fine horses he had just stolen from the logging camp.

**SARTORE, JOSEPH** - Husband of Angelina Dighera; Father of Mary Sartore Vota and Philip Amerigo Sartore; Son of Philip and Giovanna Vota Sartore- Dec 26, 1852 - Nov 23, 1916

**SARTORE, LOUIS** - Husband of Angelina Giordano; Father of Jennie Sartore Vota, Katie Sartore Baudino and Philip Joseph Sartore; Son of Fillippo and Giovanna Vota Sartore - Feb 25 (or 21), 1853 - Apr 17, 1901 -Louis had almost frozen when he slipped and fell into an ice pond. Ultimately, gangrene of the left lung set in and the death summons was sounded

**SARTORI, CHARLES (CELESTI)** - Also referred to as Charles Fattore – Died Feb 12, 1931 - Age 65 Years - Charles, a well known Austrian miner, died of myocarditis, nephritis and complications in Room 5 of the hospital

**SAUNDERS** - See Sanders

**SAUSER, JACOB** - Brother-in-law of Theodore Charles Grabowsky, Sr. - Nov 23, 1864 - May 22, 1898 - Jacob, a long time patient sufferer of Bright's disease, died at his home in Howardsville

**SAVICH, PETER THOMAS "TOMMY"** - Son of Pete Savich (Dragosavac in Serbia) and Annie Klements Kolar Savich; Brother of Helen Ruby Savich Heidy, Margaret Jane Savich Probst, Lillie Ann Savich Pergola; Half-brother of Mary Elizabeth "Mitzi" Kolar Wheeler Eaton and Johnny Mike Kolar; Grandson of Anna Klepper Klements Slabonick and John Klements

Jan 11, 1923 - Aug 8, 2003

**SAWYER, PATRICK** - Died Nov 8, 1904 - Age 40 Years - Patrick had been drinking heavily for about ten days and would lie down and sleep whenever and wherever darkness happened to overtake him. Pneumonia, coupled with his long-term alcoholism, killed him.

**SCAIA, GAUDENZIO** – Pneumonia - Jan 28, 1856 - May 13, 1901

**SCAYA** - See Scaia

**SCHAFER, SCHAEFER** - Also Spelled Shaefer, Shafer, Shaeffer, Shaffer

**SCHAEFER, DEBORAH SUE** - (Mrs. Rick Schaefer); Daughter of Charles and Elizabeth McQuarter Marrs- Feb 1, 1953 - Apr 9, 1997 - (photo on tombstone) - Deborah died at St. Peter's Hospital in Olympia, Washington. She and her husband, Rick, lived in Rochester, Washington, and had often visited Silverton.

**SCHAFER, ERMA JANE CHILL** - (Mrs. Louis Schafer); Mother of Charles Louis Schafer; Sister of Carrie Chill Crocker - 1887 - Jan 3, 1971

**SCHAFER, LOUIS** - Flu - Husband of Erma Jane Chill; Father of Charles Louis Schafer, Jr.; Son of Charles and Augusta Toepfer Schafer - Oct 3, 1887 - Oct 27, 1918

**SCHANTL, LEWIS (LUDWIG)** - Husband of Johanna - 1846 - Mar 10, 1880 - In August 1879 he received official notice from the U.S. Patent Office that his application for a patent for his reverberatory furnace had been granted. With success within his grasp, he was suddenly called to cross the dark river from whence no one ever returns.

**SCHEER, CHARLES WILLIAM, JR.** - Husband of Nancy Doshier; Son of Charles William, Sr. and Pearl Cindaff Kendall Scheer; Brother of Frank Engam "Corky" and Louis Joseph "Joe" Scheer, Pearl Audrey Scheer O'Malley and Lena Scheer Bausman - Sept 10, 1909 - before July 1993 -

**SCHEER, CHARLES WILLIAM, SR.** - Husband of Pearl Cindaff Kendall; Father of Charles William, Jr., Frank Engam "Corky" Scheer, Louis Joseph "Joe" Scheer, Lena Scheer Bausman and Pearl Audrey Scheer O'Malley; Son of John Scheer; Brother of Barbara Scheer Mier - Nov 9, 1858 - Jan 20, 1941

**SCHEER, FRANK ENGAM. "CORKY"** - Son of Charles William, Sr., and Pearl Cindaff Kendall Scheer; Brother of Charles William, Jr., Louis Joseph Scheer, Lena Scheer Bausman and Pearl Audrey Scheer O'Malley - June 4, 1914 - Aug 13, 1993

**SCHEER, NANCY G. DOSHER** - Died 1983 - (Mrs. Charles William Scheer, Jr.); Daughter of Ed and Ellie Chalk Doshier; Sister of Charles, Jr., Elmer and William J. Doshier and Eva Doshier Knight, Dorothy Doshier Fissell and Nora Doshier Chadd - 1913 - 1983

**SCHEER, PEARL KENDALL** - (Mrs. Charles William Scheer, Sr.); Mother of Charles William, Jr. and Frank Engam "Corky" Scheer, Louis Joseph "Joe" Scheer, Lena Scheer Bausman and Pearl Audrey Scheer O'Malley; Daughter of George and Bessie Bell Kendall - Sept 12, 1876 - Aug 6, 1936

**SCHIEDT, GOTTLIEB** - Husband of Mary Schmiez; Father of George Scheidt, Lena Scheidt Hoffmann and Minnie Scheidt Dickie - 1845 - Feb 2, 1929

**SCHERER, BENEDICT "BEN"** - Husband of Mary Gibson Chutchen, Marie Theobald and Mrs. Carrie Link - Jan 11, 1861 - Jan 13, 1914

**SCHERER, JOHN** - Brother of Ben Scherer - Nov 1852 - Nov 6, 1903

**SCHERER, MARY GIBSON(or GILSON) CHUTCHEN** - (Mrs. Benedict Scherer #1) - 1865 - Dec 28, 1907

**SCHERRO, FRANK** - (Also spelled Shirro) - Father of Mrs. Carl Anderson - Jan 12, 1869 - Jan 19, 1937

**SCHIELDETTI** - See Schildee

**SCHILDEE, TONY** - (Also spelled Schieldetti) - Flu - Husband of Franka - 1881 - Oct 29, 1918 - Age 37 Years - Tony died of flu at the emergency hospital set up in the Town Hall, and was buried the next day, perhaps in one of the flu trenches (mass burial)

**SCHLAPP, FRANK** - Brother of Peter Schlapp - Died Oct 2, 1925 - Age 56 Years - Frank died of miners con

**SCHLEY, C.H.** - Son of R.D. Schley - 1876 - Jan 15, 1906 - Age 30 Years - C.H., a carpenter at the Old Hundred Mill, died of pneumonia on a cold Monday morning at Mrs. Seyfer's Boarding House

**SCHLICKER** - See Schlieker

**SCHLIEKER, HENRY "DUTCH"** (Also spelled Schliker, Slicker) - Died July 3, 1889 - Age 60 Years - "Dutch" died of pneumonia

**SCHMELZER, JOSEPH CUMMINS** - Husband of Alma Barker; Son of Martin H. and Agnes Anna "Annie" Cummins Schmelzer; Brother of Charlotte Schmelzer (later Tuggle), John Fred and Leo Anthony Schmelzer; Grandson of Martin and Caroline Schmelzer and of Smith Mark and Bridget Powers Cummins - May 12, 1900 - Oct 21, 1931 - In April, just six months before his death, the very handsome Joe and Miss Alma Barker had been married at San Bernardino, California

**SCHMELZER, LEO ANTHONY** - Son of Martin H. and Agnes Anna "Annie" Cummins Schmelzer; Brother of Charlotte Schmelzer (later Tuggle), John Fred and Joseph Cummins Schmelzer; Grandson of Martin and Caroline Schmelzer and of Smith Mark and Bridget Powers Cummins - Jan 7, 1902 - June 13, 1905 - Age 3 Years - He died on a Tuesday at noon at the family home

**SCHMELZER, MARTIN H.** - Husband of Agnes Anna Cummins; Father of Charlotte Schmelzer (later Tuggle), John Fred, Joseph and Leo Anthony Schmelzer; Son of Martin and Caroline Schmelzer; Brother of Anna (or Lilla) Schmelzer Castonguay, Elizabeth Schmelzer Schaffer and Frank Schmelzer - Feb 4, 1867 - June 7, 1928

**SCHMIDT** - Also See Schmith, Schmitt, Smith

**SCHMIDT, JOHN B.** - Snowslide - Died May 11, 1905 - The bodies of John Schmidt and Wesley Hannum were found on June 11, 1905 at the mouth of the Cashier Mine on Eureka Mountain, victims of the deadly snowslide. They had been dead about 5 weeks.

**SCHMITH, WILLIAM** - Son of Jack Schmith - June 13, 1885 - Jan 30, 1958

**SCHMITT, PETER** - This name appeared in a November 1, 1918, list of the flu dead, but not in any later corrected list.

**SCHNEE, CARRIE** – Snowslide with her Grandmother - Daughter of Edward and Frances Davis Schnee; Granddaughter of Carrie Frances Clark Davis Lewis; Great-granddaughter of Robert Clark - Apr 11, 1909 - Mar 11, 1911 - Age 1 Year, 11 Months - The tranquility of the day gave no indication that the grim reaper was about to visit and gather in little Carrie Schnee and her grandmother, along with Laura Fay True and Samson Hore

**SCHNEIDER** - Also see Snyder

**SCHNEIDER, INFANT GIRL** - Drowned - Daughter of Franz Armine and Minnie Haskell Schneider - About 1880 - Aug 12, 1881 - Accidentally drowned in a tub of water

**SCHNEIDER, JACOB** - Died Dec 10, 1929 - Age 88 Years - Jacob, a prospector, carpenter and cabinet maker, was found dead in a pool of creek water a few feet from the railroad track

**SCHNEIDER, MARTIN** - Husband of Lena Arnold (later Mrs. Charles Fischer and Mrs. August Feien) - Dec 25, 1862 - May 28, 1904

**SCHOBER, HERMAN** - Snowslide - Buried at Gray Copper Falls - Also spelled Shober - Died Feb 16, 1878

**SCHOCH, LUSETTE FREY** – (Mrs. Theodore Schoch) - Suicide - Shot – Buried at Needleton - Daughter of Barbara Frey - Died Jan 6, 1889 - Age 36 Years - On that long ago cold Sunday morning, she ended her life at Needleton by shooting herself. She did not die at once.

**SCHOCK** - See Schoch

**SCHOWALTER, CHARLES "DEAF CHARLIE"** - Exhaustion and Exposure - Died Mar 10, 1908 - Age 55 Years - On a freezing day in March, "Deaf Charlie" was found dead on the Ouray trail
