**WADDINGTON, SARAH (SALLY) HABITA KOZA** - (Mrs. Herold Alvin Waddington); Daughter of Bartholomew and Agnes Siek Koza; Sister of Katherine Koza Maxwell, Josephine, Stanley and Alexander Koza - Dec 29, 1909 - Aug 17 or 18, 1991

**WAECHTER, LAWRENCE** - Aug 12, 1863 - May 28, 1927

**WAGNER, WILLIAM "BUTCH"** - Feb 28, 1857 - July 8, 1914

**WAHL, BRITT** - Also spelled Wall – Snowslide - Died Dec 25, 1883 - Britt met his death in a snowslide on Christmas night

**WAHLBERG, GUS** - Typhoid Fever - Brother of Claes Wahlberg - Died Sept 19, 1898 - Age 25 Years - Early on a Tuesday morning the grim reaper swung his sickle and cut down, in the vigor and pride of young manhood, Gus Wahlberg.

**WALDBERG** - See Wahlberg

**WALDRON, MARY BALL** - (Mrs. James W. Waldron); Daughter of Martin and Mary McNessey Ball - Died Feb 19, 1908 - Age 44 Years - Mary, afflicted with rheumatism since childhood, died at her home in Gladstone.

**WALKER, BOBBY** – 1848 - Jan 9, 1931

**WALKER, ELIZA S. HAYES** - (Mrs. William Shockley "Cap" Walker); Daughter of Robert and Ann Smith Hayes; Sister of Frances Hayes and Hattie Hayes Bainum - Sept 15, 1827 - Dec 12, 1904

**WALKER, GERTIE** - 1876 - Nov 26, 1892 - Age 16 Years - died of inflammation of the bowels

**WALKER, JAMES E.** - Typhoid - Son of James and Myrtle Walker - May 23, 1875 - Dec 27, 1916

**WALKER, JOSEPH "JOE"** - Snowslide - Son of John and Elizabeth Walker; Uncle of Mrs. Martha OWalker - 1872 - Mar 17, 1906

**WALKER, NELLIE** - Daughter of Mr. and Mrs. David Walker - Died Aug 26, 1893

**WALKER, ROBERT ARTHUR** - Twin son of Phillip C. and Louise M. Cope Walker; Twin brother of William Elmer Walker - Died Jan 23, 1925 - the second born twin, Robert Arthur, was stillborn

**WALKER, WILLIAM SHOCKLEY "CAP"** - Husband of Eliza S. Hayes; Brother of Mrs. Martha Tschudi; Uncle of Mary G. Price - June 27, 1821 - Oct 24, 1900 - A terrible accident at Ophir befell respected Silverton townsman, Cap Walker

**WALL, BRITT** - See Wahl, Britt

**WALLER, FRANK** - Husband of Edith Meyer (later Miller); Father of Frank John Waller - Died Jan 20, 1897 - Age 38 Years - With Frank's death another name was added to the list of those who have joined the silent majority

**WALSH** - Also see Welsh

**WALSH, JAMES** - See Wamsley, James

**WALTER, F.W.A. "OLD MAN WALTER"** - Died Sept 16, 1898 (approximately) - found dead, his body in a horrible state of decomposition

**WALTER, JESSIE MENCIMER** - (Mrs. Edward William Walter); Mother of Thelma Minnie Walter Alling; Daughter of John Mencimer - Aug 26, 1874 - Dec 30, 1936

**WALTERS, FRED** - Died Sept 1898

**WAMPLER, JOHN W.** - Son of William Wampler - 1852 - Oct 31, 1934

**WAMSLEY, JAMES** - Also known as James Walsh/Welsh - Died Sept 11, 1905 - James died at the Teller House on Greene Street due to heart problems and alcoholism

**WARNOCK** - See Whermick

**WARREN, GRACIE ALDER** – Prostitute - Died Jan 4, 1906 - Age 36 Years - Gracie, an inmate of one of the Blair Street dance halls, was ill five days before she succumbed to pneumonia and alcoholism

**WARREN, INFANT BOY** - Son of Frank and Mrs. Warren - Aug 9, 1890 - Nov 20, 1890 - Age 3 Months 11 Days - "How much of light, how much of joy, was buried with that little boy!"

**WASEM, ADELIN MORELAND PLANTZ** - (Mrs. Rudy Wasem) - Daughter of George Parker and Ellen Chivers Plantz; Granddaughter of T. Parker Plantz; Sister of Maud F., Phebe E., Charles G., Edna May, Ralph Albert, Edith Alice and May Tunny Plantz; Granddaughter of John M. Chivers - June 30, 1898 - April 10, 1998 - Addie died in Yuba City California a few days after falling and breaking her hip. She was buried in California, and a memorial marker was placed in Hillside Cemetery in 1999. Addie

loved Silverton and longed to be able to see it once again.

**WASSON, ANGENETTE** - (Also known as Patsy Johnson) – Prostitute - 1881 - June 7, 1903 - Age 22 Years - A girl known as Patsy Johnson, who worked at Luke's Dance Hall, died about noon on a summer Sunday

**WATSON, ALBERT ZOLLICOFFER** - Husband of J.M. and of Mary Lechner; Father of Frank Lowe, Barney Albert, William Downing "Billy", Thomas Lechner and Lena A. Watson; Son of William Downing and Nancy Anne Newcomb Watson; Brother of Mary Watson Wilson Emens, Frank L., George Alexander and John Henry Watson; Grandson of John H. and Lucinda Courtright Newcomb and of John Harwood and Elizabeth Rankin Watson - Mar 3, 1862 - Nov 7, 1915 - Again the town was alarmed by the chanting of the solemn dirge that marked the departure of man into everlasting life.

**WATSON, FRANK L.** - Husband of Helena Catherine Fisher; Father of Ruth Catherine Watson Etchison; Son of William Downing and Nancy Anne Newcomb Watson; Brother of Mary Watson Wilson Emens, Albert Zollicoffer, George Alexander and John Henry Watson; Grandson of John H. and Lucinda Courtright Newcomb and of John Harwood and Elizabeth Rankin Watson - Dec 28, 1868 - Dec 5, 1926

**WATSON, FRANK LOWE** - Son of Albert Zollicoffer and J.M. Watson; Half-brother of Barney Albert, William Downing "Billy", Thomas Lechner and Lena A. Watson; Grandson of William Downing and Nancy Anne Newcomb Watson; Great-grandson of John H. and Lucinda Courtright Newcomb and of John Harwood and Elizabeth Rankin Watson - Nov 7, 1890 - Nov 24, 1890 - Age 17 Days - Frank, the only child of Albert and J.M., died of pneumonia. Ten days later, his cousin, Ollie Watson, also died of pneumonia at the age of seventeen days.

**WATSON, GEORGE ALEXANDER** - Husband of Clara Mabel Albee; Father of Frank Albee "Baby Jim", Dorothy and Squire Watson; Son of William Downing and Nancy Anne Newcomb Watson; Brother of Mary Watson Wilson Emens, Albert Zollicoffer, Frank L. and John Henry Watson; Grandson of John H. and Lucinda Courtright Newcomb and of John Harwood and Elizabeth Rankin Watson - Apr 19, 1866 - Oct 2, 1912

**WATSON, JOHN HENRY** - Husband of Hattie Sherman and of Alice J. Murphy; Father of Son born 1888 and Ollie (first marriage), and Helen, Glenwood S. and Joel (second marriage); Son of William Downing and Nancy Anne Newcomb Watson; Brother of Mary Watson Wilson Emens, Albert Zollicoffer, Frank L. and George Alexander Watson; Grandson of John H. and Lucinda Courtright Newcomb and of John Harwood and Elizabeth Rankin Watson - Sept 7, 1857 - Mar 10, 1911

**WATSON, JOSIAH** - Husband of Laura Sayre; Father of Lawrence Waldo, Vern and Vera Watson; Son of Mike Watson - Apr 26, 1850 - Mar 10, 1930

**WATSON, LENA A.** - Scarlet Fever and Meningitis - Daughter of Albert Zollicoffer and Mary Lechner Foster Watson; Sister of Thomas Lechner, Barney and Billy Watson; Half-sister of Frank Lowe Watson; Granddaughter of William Downing and Nancy Anne Newcomb Watson; Great-granddaughter of John H. and Lucinda Courtright Newcomb and of John Harwood and Elizabeth Rankin Watson - Mar 6, 1902 - June 24, 1905 - Age 3 Years, 3 Months - "She was the sunshine of our home"

**WATSON, LYNN OWEN** - Husband of Connie Goddard; Father of Thomas, Michael and Mark Watson; Son of Charles M. and Mary R. Maxey Watson; Brother of Gerald Watson and Becky Watson Bennett - Dec 28, 1940 - Jan 1, 1994

**WATSON, NANCY ANNE NEWCOMB** - (Mrs. William Downing "Squire" Watson); Mother of Mary Watson Wilson Emens, Albert Zollicoffer, Frank L., George Alexander and John Henry Watson; Daughter of John H. and Lucinda Courtright Newcomb - Oct 25, 1840 - Feb 24, 1911

**WATSON, OLLIE P.** - Pneumonia - Son of John Henry and Hattie Sherman Watson; Brother of boy born 1888; Half-brother of Helen, Glenwood and Joel Watson; Grandson of William Downing and Nancy Anne Newcomb Watson; Great-grandson of John H. and Lucinda Courtright Newcomb and of John Harwood and Elizabeth Rankin Watson - Nov 17, 1890 - Dec 4, 1890 - Age 17 Days

**WATSON, THOMAS LECHNER** - Son of Albert Z. and Mary Lechner Foster Watson; Brother of Barney Albert, William D. "Billy" and Lena A. Watson; Half-brother of Frank Lowe Watson; Grandson of William Downing and Nancy Anne Newcomb Watson; Great-grandson of John H. and Lucinda Courtright Newcomb and of John Harwood and Elizabeth Rankin Watson - Sept 16, 1909 - Feb 14, 1910 - Age 5 Months - Tommy died after a lingering illness which baffled all medical skill and parental care

**WATSON, VERA** - Daughter of Josiah and Laura Sayre Watson; Sister of Lawrence Waldo and Vern

Watson; Granddaughter of Mike Watson - July 12, 1895 - Sept 1896 - Age 13 Months  
**WATSON, WILLIAM DOWNING "SQUIRE"** - Husband of Nancy Anne Newcomb; Father of Mary Watson Wilson Emens, Albert Zollicoffer, Frank L., George Alexander and John Henry Watson; Son of John Harwood and Elizabeth "Betsy" Rankin Watson; Grandson of Dr. John and Frances Pace Watson; Brother of Samuel Henry, Thomas P., Joel Perry, James Harvey. John R. and Nancy Virginia Watson, Amelia Jane Watson (Mrs. B.F.) Miller and Millie Frances Watson (Mrs. John) Wall - Apr 30, 1831 - July 7, 1916 - Once more the solemn dirge was heard as it chanted the departure of Silverton's Grand Old Man.

**WESTLAND, VICTOR** - Explosion - 1880 - Nov 7, 1906 - just after going on shift, Vic was blown up and killed by a missed shot in the seventh level of the Mogul Mine  
**WHEELER, EDWARD CHARLES** - Husband of Mary Elizabeth Kolar (later Eaton); Father of Edward Charles, Jr. and Dennis John Wheeler; Son of Edward Eastman and Minnie P. Chapman Wheeler; Brother of Doris C. Wheeler Wells, Frances Wheeler Wallis and Helen Wheeler; Grandson of Walter F. Wheeler - Aug 16, 1908 - Sept 10, 1937  
**WHEELER, JULIA** - Died 1896 - Prostitute - Died Mar 7, 1896 - "All her sins are now forgiven, and may she rest in peace."  
**WHERMICK, JAHOP "JAKE"** - Flu - Died Oct 27, 1918 - Age 30 Years  
**WHITE, CHARLES LEON "SONNY"** - Son of Clyde Leon "Stub" and Lila Florence Edwards White; Step-son of Ethel Dwilla Caine White; Brother of Georgia Louise White (later Davis), Mary Pauline White (later Stocks and Deaken), and Robert Lewis (White) Caine; Half-brother of John Benjamin and Paul Leon White - June 19, 1936 - Aug 2, 1949  
**WHITE, GREGORY TREMLETT** - Son of Arthur and Evelyn White; Brother of Cynthia Poulin, Pamela Caraffa, Patricia and Christopher White - Dec 25, 1954 - Sept 17, 1989  
**WHITE, HARRY** - Suicide - 1856 - Apr 20, 1906  
**WHITE, LILA FLORENCE EDWARDS** - (Mrs. Clyde Leon "Stub" White); Mother of Charles Leon "Sonny" White, Georgia Louise White (later Davis), Mary Pauline White (later Stocks and Deaken) and

Robert Lewis "Bobby" White (later Caine); Daughter of Albert and Pauline Scheer Edwards; Sister of Albert Paul, Lewis Arthur and Willard Edwards- Apr 4, 1917 - Apr 20, 1942

**WHITE, PATRICK "PADDY"** - Died Nov 3, 1902 - Age 42 Years - Patrick, an American-born Irishman, died of miners consumption

**WHITE, ROBERT FRANKLIN, JR. "BOB"** - Drowned - Husband of Sara; Father of Kim, Kristi and Kendrick White - June 8, 1941 - Sept 21, 1976

**WHITE, W.H. "HARRY"** - See White, Harry

**WHITFORD, WILLIAM** - Explosion - Died Feb 25, 1903 - Age 28 or 44 Years ... accounts differed - Born in Cornwall, his wife and three small children would receive there the sad and distressing news of the terrible fate of the husband and father

**WHITMAN, WILLIAM** - See Whitford, William

**WHITTEN, CHARLES** - 1836 - Jan 6, 1918

**WICK, JOHN PETER "DAD"** - Husband of Marguerita Juliana "Julia" Carlson; Father of Alma Wick Brendel, Bessie Amalia Wick Lundin, Lucille A. Wick Kleinhapl Bland, Lydia Wick Tiedmann, Marguerite Thelma Wick, Carl Wick, John Elmer Wick and Leon Wick - Apr 12, 1856 - Dec 20, 1917

**WICK, MARGUERITE THELMA** - Daughter of John Peter and Marguerita Juliana "Julia" Carlson Wick; Sister of Carl Wick, Alma Wick Brendel, Lydia Wick Tiedmann, Leon Wick, Bessie Amalia Wick Lundin, John Elmer Wick and Lucille A. Wick Kleinhapl Bland - Sept 8, 1900 - Mar 23, 1919

**WICKSTROM, WILLIAM JULIUS** - Skull Fractured by Falling Chimney - 1862 - July 8, 1904

**WILL, WILLIAM** - Son of George C. and Minnie Will - Apr 19, 1904 - Apr 21, 1904 - Age 2 Days

**WILLARD, FRANCIS** - Died Feb 18, 1898

**WILLIAMS, ALFRED** - Died Feb 7, 1896 - Age 33 Years

**WILLIAMS, CASH** - Died May 23, 1920 - Age 65 Years

**WILLIAMS, HARRY** - Died Aug 17, 1910 - Age 28 Years

**WILLIAMS, JAMES** - Died Aug 24, 1896 - James, a miner at the Silver Lake, died of pneumonia

**WILLIAMS, JAMES PETER** - Flu - Husband of Mary Ella Huebner Estabrook (or Esterbrook) - Died Nov 4, 1918

**WILLIAMS, JAMES S.** - 1852 - Dec 14, 1905

**WILLIAMS, JOBE** - 1861 - Dec 16, 1911

**WILLIAMS, JOHN W. "JOHNNY-BEHIND-THE-ROCK"** - June 8, 1839 - Oct 6, 1921

**WILLIAMS, KATHERINE** - "Denver Kate" - Prostitute - Died July 16, 1925

**WILLIAMS, MARION A.** - (Mrs. Jessie D. Williams) - July 28, 1839 - May 1, 1893

**WILLIAMS, MARY ELLA HUEBNER ESTABROOK** (or Esterbrook) - Flu - (Mrs. James Peter Williams); Daughter of Frederick John and Amelia Huebner; Sister of Lena Huebner Edwin; Aunt of Gordon L. Potter - 1884 - Nov 16, 1918 - Ella and her husband, Jim, both died in the tragic flu epidemic

**WILLIAMS, ROBERT F.** - Died Aug 13, 1909 - Age 65 Years

**WILLIAMS, THOMAS** - Died Mar 21, 1892 - Tom had long been sick with miners consumption

**WILLIAMSON, HENRY** - Died Apr 19, 1920 - Age 40 Years

**WILLIAMSON, ROBERT** - Mar 17, 1869 - Jan 31, 1929

**WILLIMICK** - See Wilimick

**WILLIS, RAY DAVID** - Husband of Rosa Duenweg; Father of Cora May, David, Hugo "Pat", Robert and Elmer Willis; Brother of Mrs. J.R. George - May 22, 1876 - May 14, 1956

**WILMER, LEWIS F.** - July 3, 1908 - Aug 23, 1973

**WILSON, DUNLAP** - Died July 14, 1887 - Age 38 Years

**WILSON, H. BLAIR, COLONEL** - Civil War Veteran - 1826 - July 14, 1882 - It is possible he was later moved to Ohio

**WILSON, TUG** - See Collins, George

**WILSON, WILLIAM "BILLY"** - Murdered - Son of Gertrude Hawley; Brother of Lizzie Hawley - Died June 22, 1884 - Age 34 Years

**WILSON, WILLIAM D.** - Snowslide - Died Feb 5, 1891 - Age 38 Years . Wilson was caught in the center of the slide and swept on down the side of the mountain, rolling over and over with the mule in the

massive billows of snow.

**WILSON, WILLIE** - Son of Walter B. and Annie Melville Wilson - Feb 22, 1885 - Mar 17, 1885 - Age 3 Weeks

**WINTERS, WILLIAM ROBERT, DR.** - Husband of Julia Elizabeth Lewis (later Mrs. Bird); Father of Ruth Isabel Winters DeVaughan McCray - May 1850 - Jan 7, 1908 - One of the most brilliant surgeons of his time; in his last years of life, he was ill, poor, despondent and mostly alone. He had a rare mind, and rare ability, and what he had accomplished in surgery in those rugged pioneer times, under extremely primitive conditions in a very harsh country, was indeed extraordinary and miraculous.

**WIPF, WALLACE WAYNE** - Former Husband of Cleo Schrag; Father of Tommy, Jeffrey, Pamela and Debra Wipf- Dec 18, 1922 - May 24, 1985

**WIZOREK, ALBERT** - Snowslide - Died Mar 19, 1919 - Age 27 Years - Albert was killed in a snowslide which also claimed the life of Jack Seay, and very severely injured Frank Wilmers

**WOLFE, FREDERICK STOCK** - Husband of Gloria Piccoli Theurer; Father of Linda and Steven Wolfe - Jan 18, 1928 - Mar 13, 1989

**WOLFE, NICHOLAS** - Died Jan 21, 1902 - Age 35 Years - Nick died of pneumonia and alcoholism

**WOMACK, VELMA** - Daughter of James Larkin and Luella Myrtle Leap Womack; Sister of Irvin, James, Len, Owen, Virgil and Doris Luella Womack; Granddaughter of Mrs. Mattie Rush- July 13, 1911 - Jan 29, 1927 - Age 15 Years - Sorrow lurks everywhere

**WOODWORTH, LEILA MARGARET GRIMES** - (Mrs. Howard Woodworth) - Mother of Steven G. Woodworth and Wendy Woodworth Markowitz; Grandmother of Max Markowitz; Daughter of Eugene and Ida Lundberg Grimes; Granddaughter of Verner and Anna Forsell Lundberg and of William and Emma Corley Grimes - Oct 28, 1921 - Aug 14, 1986

**WOOLCOCK, INFANT GIRL** - Died June 7, 1890 - Age 3 Weeks

**WOOLCOT, MARY** - Liquor and Abuse - Prostitute - (Also known as Mary Reany) - Died Sept 21, 1889 - Age 26 Years

**WORTMAN, ANTHONY** - Son of Anthony and Katherine Hunter Wortman - Died July 1, 1929

**WRIGHT, BEN** - See Wright, Isaac Benjamin

**WRIGHT, DELIA ANASTASIA "ISABELL"** - Flu - Daughter of Ben and Delia Smart Wright; Sister of Isaac Benjamin, Jr., Francis Neill "Frank", Edith, Irene Elizabeth and Leona Wright; Granddaughter of James and Harriet Carter Smart- June 22, 1915 - Nov 3, 1918 - Age 3 Years

**WRIGHT, DELIA NEILL SMART** - Flu - (Mrs. Ben Wright, Sr.) - Mother of Isaac Benjamin, Jr., Francis Neill "Frank", Delia Anastasia "Isabell", Edith, Irene Elizabeth and Leona Wright; Daughter of James and Harriet Carter Smart - Mar 29, 1878 - Nov 1, 1918

**WRIGHT, HENRY** - See Wright, Robert Henry
